Long within the courthouse building and during the hours of his employment; therefore, upon motion made and duly seconded, the following order was passed: that the services of Leamon P. Long, custodian of County buildings, are hereby terminated as of this date, and that J. Hubert Norris, Supervisor of Buildings, be authorized to employ a custodian upon the approval of the Board of Commissioners.

Chairman Watts stated to the Board that he had received an order of court, directed to the Board of Commissioners, signed by Hamilton H. Hobgood, Judge Presiding at the September term of Columbus County Superior Court, concerning the county jail and rest rooms as set forth in the Grand Jury Report.
