Ordered: that the proposed zoning ordinance for the Southeastern Community College Area be adopted.

The Clerk to the Board was instructed to write Southern Appraisal Co. of Greensboro requesting them to meet with the Board of Equalization and Review in March 1966.

Ordered: that \$500 be appropriated to secure engineering services for sewer line extending from the city limits westward to the site of the State Highway Patrol lot.
