- 1. No political control of funds or operations at either the tri-county or individual county level.
- 2. Equal representation on the governing body, regardless of individual county population.
- 3. Administrative expenses for the tri-county level, and project support share for those projects equally effective in all counties, to be assessed in proportion to populations of the three counties.
- 4. That each county will continue to maintain its individual community action organization to support the tri-county organization."
