

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office at 10 a.m., November 1, 1965 it being first Monday.

The following business was transacted:

T. Ward Guy, Superintendent, County Board of Education, presented the schools' long-range program, worked up jointly with the Whiteville Board of Education, pointing out certain facts and trends.

Dr. Jesse Fisher appeared before the Board to report the progress made on our joint community action program (anti-poverty) with Bladen and Brunswick counties. In accordance with his request for a statement of support from the Board, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

"Be it RESOLVED that the Columbus County Board of Commissioners hereby approves the formation of a tri-county organization (SENCLAND COMMUNITY ACTION, INC.) to pursue a joint program with Bladen and Brunswick Counties, North Carolina, subject to the following statement of principle to govern the organization:

1. No political control of funds or operations at either the tri-county or individual county level.
2. Equal representation on the governing body, regardless of individual county population.
3. Administrative expenses for the tri-county level, and project support share for those projects equally effective in all counties, to be assessed in proportion to populations of the three counties.
4. That each county will continue to maintain its individual community action organization to support the tri-county organization."

Ordered: that B. E. Delamater be appointed to the Riegelwood Sanitary District Board of Commissioners to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Kenneth N. Tice. It was further ordered that William Godwin be appointed to fill the unexpired term of A. B. Gregory upon his resignation January 1, 1966.

Ordered: that a check from the Out Door Poor fund in the amount of \$25.00 be given to William David Williams.

Ordered: that the 1965-1966 budget of the Forest Service be amended by an increase of \$650.00.

Ordered: that Southern Appraisal Company of Greensboro be employed to appraise new construction in Columbus County for the tax year 1966, said employment to begin March 14, 1966.

Ordered: that the following persons be appointed to the Board of Adjustments, Town of Whiteville, as required by the Zoning Ordinance of the Town of Whiteville and the general statutes of the State of North Carolina:

WHEREAS the State Highway Patrol has requested sufficient land upon which to construct a Patrol Barracks, and it is necessary, in order to provide sufficient lands, to obtain a portion of the lands conveyed to North Carolina for the construction of a National Guard Armory,

THEREFORE, the County Board of Commissioners respectfully requests that the State of North Carolina convey from the Armory site a sufficient amount of property to meet the requirements of the North Carolina State Highway Patrol.

It was ordered, upon the county securing a sufficient site, that H. J. Watts, Chairman of the Board of Commissioners, be authorized to execute a deed in behalf of the County Board of Commissioners to the State of North Carolina for a Highway Patrol Building.
