The following resolution was introduced by Commissioner Burns and was duly adopted:

WHEREAS a weed known as alligator weed has invaded a number of ditches and canals in Columbus County, and

WHEREAS this alligator weed has become a noxious weed and pest, both in the streams in and around Lake Waccamaw and in the Chadbourn area, and

WHEREAS this weed has become a serious pest on a number of farms in the Chadbourn area,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that we, the Board of County Commissioners in Columbus County, after having discussed this situation with the Corps of Engineers, Wilmington District, earnestly request and solicit your cooperation from the Water Resources Division to assist the Corps of Engineers in helping to eradicate alligator weed from Columbus County.

We are under the impression that this would come under the Expanded Aquatic Plant Control Project provided by Section 104 of Public Law 85-500.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that we, the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County, are greatly interested in eradicating this pest from our lake, streams and farms and we earnestly solicit your help in the control and eradication of alligator weed in Columbus County.
