Commissioner T. E. Burns introduced the following resolution which was read:

RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF \$500,000  
COMMUNITY COLLEGE BONDS

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners for the County of Columbus:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners has determined and does hereby find and declare:

- (a) That an order authorizing \$500,000 Community College Bonds of the County of Columbus was finally passed on December 9, 1963, which order was approved by the vote of a majority of the qualified voters of said County who voted thereon at an election duly called and held on January 14, 1964.
- (b) That none of said bonds has been issued and that a \$60,000 Community College Bond Anticipation Note is outstanding which was issued in anticipation of the receipt of the proceeds of a like amount of said bonds, which note is dated December 8, 1965 and matures on June 8, 1966 and bears interest at the rate of 2-3/4% per annum.
- (c) That it is necessary to issue all of said bonds, \$60,000 of the proceeds thereof to be used to pay the note which matures June 8, 1966.
- (d) That the period of the life of the Community College to be constructed pursuant to said order is estimated as a period of thirty years from December 9, 1964, being a date not later than one year after the final passage of said order, and that such period expires on December 9, 1994.

Section 2. For the purpose provided in said order there shall be issued the negotiable coupon bonds of the County of Columbus in the aggregate principal amount of \$500,000 designated "Community College Bonds", dated March 1, 1966, consisting of 500 bonds of the denomination of \$1,000 each, numbered 1 to 500, inclusive, unless, pursuant to the provisions of the notice of sale for said bonds published by the Local Government Commission, the successful bidder for said bonds shall request \$5,000 denominations, in which event said bonds shall consist of 100 bonds of the denomination of \$5,000 each, numbered 1 to 100, inclusive. Said bonds shall mature annually, March 1, in numerical order, lowest numbers first, \$15,000 1967 to 1977, \$35,000 1978 to 1986, all inclusive, and \$20,000 1987, without option of prior payment, shall bear interest from their date at a rate or rates not exceeding 6% per annum to be determined by the Local Government Commission at the time the bonds are sold, which interest to the maturity thereof shall be payable semi-annually on the 1st days of March and September of each year, and both the principal of and the interest on said bonds shall be payable at Manufacturers Hanover Trust Company, in the Borough of Manhattan, City and State of New York, in any coin or currency of the United States of America which, at the respective dates of payment thereof, is legal tender for the payment of public and private debts.

Section 3. Said bonds shall be signed by the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners and by the Clerk of said Board, and the corporate seal of said County shall be affixed to the bonds, and the interest coupons to be attached to said bonds shall be executed with the facsimile signature of said Clerk. Said bonds and coupons and the endorsements to be printed upon the reverse ~~xi~~ of said bonds shall be in substantially the following forms:

For the prompt payment hereof, both principal and interest as the same shall become due, the full faith and credit of said County of Columbus are hereby irrevocably pledged.

This bond is one of a series issued by said County for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for constructing buildings for a community college in said County, and acquiring any necessary land and equipment therefor, and this bond is issued under and pursuant to Chapter 115A of the General Statutes of North Carolina, The County Finance Act, as amended, and the Local Government Act, as amended, and an order which was approved by the vote of a majority of the qualified voters of said County who voted thereon at an election duly called and held, and resolutions duly passed by the Board of Commissioners for said County.

It is hereby certified and recited that all acts, conditions and things required to happen, exist and be performed precedent to and in the issuance of this bond by the Constitution and laws of North Carolina have happened, exist and have been performed in regular and due form and time as so required; that provision has been made for the levy and collection of a direct annual tax upon all taxable property within said County sufficient to pay the principal of and the interest on this bond as the same shall become due; and that the total indebtedness of said County, including this bond, does not exceed any constitutional or statutory limitation thereon.

This bond may be registered as to principal alone in accordance with the provisions endorsed hereon.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, said County of Columbus, by order of its Board of Commissioners, has caused this bond to be signed by the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners and by the Clerk of said Board, and the corporate seal of said County to be affixed hereto, and has caused the interest coupons attached hereto to be executed with the facsimile signature of said Clerk, all as of the 1st day of March, 1966.
