Ordered: that J. Hubert Norris be appointed tax collector, pre-payment collector, delinquent tax collector, and schedule "B" collector for the fiscal year 1966-67. It is further ordered that Brooks Stanley be named deputy tax collector for the fiscal year 1966-67.

Ordered: that the resignation of Daisy Ann Hill, secretary in the Agriculture Extension Office, be accepted effective July 15, 1966.

Ordered: that Purvis Stevens of Wananish, be appointed constable for Waccamaw Township to fill the unexpired term of Constable Bob Hoffman, deceased.

Ordered: that the superintendent of buildings be authorized to make office space available for the social security personnel on Monday and Thursday weekly, and that the two offices heretofore occupied by said personnel be assigned to the FHA for their use.
