At the request of Dr. J. R. Black, Health Director, it was ordered that office hours of the Health Department be 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. effective immediately.

Mr. Bozeman of Tyson & Van Advertising Co. presented a proposed estimate on identification signs for the County Hall and Courthouse. Action on this matter was tabled until the exterior repairs to the Courthouse are completed.

Motion was made by Com. Burns, seconded by Com. Gore, and unanimously carried that J. Hubert Norris be authorized to purchase and have installed the lighting proposed for the inside halls and entrances of the courthouse according to the specifications presented to the Board at this meeting, at the lowest possible price, not to exceed \$1,523 for the inside hall, \$1,272 for the entrances, and \$125 for a panel, and that money be appropriated out of surplus to cover said lighting. It was further ordered that this work be done by the contractor as an independent contractor and not as an employee of Columbus County, and that he be required to carry Workman's Compensation Insurance.

Ordered: that the Welfare Department be authorized to certify needy families to receive surplus commodities beginning December 1, 1966.

Ordered: that the chairman and clerk be authorized to sign Bond, Interest, and Redemption voucher in the amount of \$1,480.00 to pay the following debt service due November 1st, 1966:
