Richard P. Mauney, Executive Secretary of the Economic Development Commission, appeared before the Board to request permission to transfer funds with which to pay the salary of a substitute stenographer in the absence of Mrs. Doris S. Hughes, regular stenographer on sick leave. The request was not granted due to the fact that the Board felt it was not in keeping with prior sick leave practices.

Ordered: that Com. Edward W. Williamson be appointed to serve on the Board of Directors of SENCland Community Action Agency, Inc. for a period of one year.

Jack Hooks, attorney for the Whiteville City Schools and C. W. Duggins, superintendent, appeared before the Board to file a petition for a local election to impose a separate local supplement tax for the use of Whiteville City Schools. It was ordered that the petition of the Whiteville Board of Education requesting an election to determine a local supplement tax be approved and that the date for said election be fixed for April 11,1967.
