The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that the resignation of Joe W. Brown, Solicitor of Records Court, be accepted with regret. The Board expressed their appreciation for the services he has rendered to the county in various offices held during the past 31 years.

Ordered: that Richard E. Weaver be appointed to serve as temporary Solicitor of Records Court.

Ordered: that the resignation of Roy Nunnery, Chadbourn Township Constable, be accepted.

Ordered: that D. D. Barfield be appointed to fill the unexpired term of Chadbourn Township Constable.

Ordered: that James E. Inman, Cerro Gordo, N. C., be given a check in the amount of \$25.00 from the Out Door Poor Fund.

Ordered: that the clerk be authorized to pay an overdraft of \$102.19 to the N. C. Department of Forestry Service. This overdraft occurred in the fiscal year 1965-1966.

Mr. James C. Cox, a representative of the Sencland Community Action Program, appeared before the Board and presented a progress report of the Proverty Program in Columbus County. This report covered the period from May 1966 of which this program began, through the current month.

Dr. J. R. Black appeared before the Board to discuss a retirement plan for the County Health Department employees. This report included the amount of money the county would supply and also the proportionate part the state would supply. No definate decision was made.

Approval of the Board was given to Mr. C. D. Raper, County Extension Chairman, concerning employees in his department attending a work shop at State College, Raleigh, N. C., one day each week beginning with the fall term.

WHEREAS, Stone Manufacturing Company is desirous of changing State Road No. 1400 located in the area of their Plant, and

RESOLVED, that the Board of Columbus County Commissioners hereby authorize and consent to the change in State Road No. 1400 and make this Resolution for the purpose of complying with North Carolina General Statutes 136-60.

A letter was written by Commissioner Johnson to Congressman Alton A. Lennon concerning flood protection for the Waccamaw River, North Carolina and South Carolina. The following resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED, by the Committee on Public Works of the House of Representatives, United States, that the Board of Engineers for Rivers and Harbors is hereby requested to review the report of the Chief of Engineers on Waccamaw River, North Carolina and South Carolina, transmitted to Congress on December 22, 1966, and prior reports, to determine the advisability of modifying the recommendations with particular reference to providing flood protection to the main stem and the tributary areas and to development and maximum utilization of the water resources of the basin.
