The following business was transacted:

A delegation from the Columbus Soil & Water Conservation Department with Mr. Frank Glover as spokesman, appeared before the Board of Commissioners and asked they write a letter of endorsement to Secretary of Agriculture, Orville Freeman, concerning the Frair Swamp Water Shed in Columbus and Bladen Counties.

Ordered: that a check in the amount of \$150.00 be written to the Columbus Soil & Water Conservation District to help with expenses of holding their annual election.

Ordered: that a check in the amount of \$20.00 be written from the Out Door Poor Fund and given to Mrs. Lizzie Johnson, Tabor City, N. C.

Ordered: that the County Extension office, at the request of Mr. C. D. Raper, be closed on November 14, 1967, so all personel will be able to attend a meeting in Goldsboro, N. C.

Mr. Donald Williams Baker appeared before the Board with Mr. C. D. Raper, County Extension Chairman, and was interviewed and questioned as to his qualifications for the position of assistant county agent. Mr. Raper recommended Mr. Baker as being well qualified for this position. Upon motion made by Commissioner Williamson and seconded by Commissioner Watts, and unanimously carried, it was ordered that Mr. Baker be hired with duties to begin on January 1, 1968, as assistant county agent.

Ordered: that the salary of Court Reporter be increased from \$125.00 per week to \$150.00 per week.

Ordered: that county employees be given Friday, November 24, 1967 following Thanksgiving in lieu of November 11, 1967, Armistic Day which is on Saturday this year.

Ordered: that the Board of County Commissioners certify and approve the use of available public county buildings and property which are not used by other agencies for the SENCland Community Action Program, as Columbus County's source of non-federal share of the Community Action budget.

Mr. Edward L. Williamson and Mr. Besley Strickland appeared before the Board in behalf of the Gapway Watershed District and asked the county for a loan of \$5,000 to pay for engineering, etc. until a loan could be secured from FHA. The Board expressed their interest in the progress of this project but stated they are unable to make a loan of \$5,000 at this time. However, the Board asked Mr. Williamson to contact the Columbus County Economic Development Commission to make arrangements with them for the above loan.
