The Columbus County Planning Committee appeared before the Board and presented their proposed plan # 1 for this project in the county. The Harwood Beebe Company, Consulting Engineers, was represented by Mr. Bob Carroll. No action as to the acceptance of this plan was taken due to the fact there was not a majority vote present from the Planning Committee.

Hugh Clark, FHA representative also attended this meeting and advised that funds in the amount of \$13,920 would be available within ten days for deposit in a local bank. The Columbus County Economic Development Commission will contribute \$500. The total cost of the study is estimated to be \$14,420.

Ordered: that the funds from FHA to be applied to the comprehensive water and sewer study in Columbus County be deposited in Waccamaw Bank & Trust Company. FHA will countersign all checks.

Ordered: that Dr. J. R. Black, in connection with the Sanitary Sewer System Project be authorized to have the three county buildings tapped on and stacks completed at an approximate cost of \$300. Dr. Black was also requested to obtain estimates from several plumbers for further cost of connecting to sewer system.
