The county attorney reported to the Board he had met with the Jury Commission and received the final report which appeared to be thorough and proper in all respects. A copy of this report was presented to the County Commissioners and was reviewed by each of them. The Board wishes to express its appreciation to the Jury Commission for a job well done.

L. R. Wayne, Civil Defense Director, appeared before the Board and requested that he be given office space in the County Hall building when a vacancy occurs. Mr. Wayne was assured by the Board if and when a vacancy occurs he would be given this space.

The following bids were presented to the Board by Dr. J. R. Black. Dr. Black was instructed by the Board at a prior meeting to contact several plumbing companies for bids on plumbing that would be necessary for county buildings to be tapped on the Sanitary Sewer Extension Project now underway:

Whiteville Plumbing Company was awarded the contract being low bidder.

Representatives from funeral homes throughout the county met with the Board and gave notice that the represented funeral homes would no longer offer ambulance service as of midnight January 9, 1968. Spokesman for the group was A. D. Peacock. The reasons stated for withdrawing was due to the fact the funeral homes could not comply with the new requirements of the state board of health and the hardship of meeting minimum salaries required under the minimum wage law.

This Board wishes to go on record as expressing its appreciation to all of the county funeral homes, ambulance companies and rescue squads for services they have rendered to all the people of Columbus County and for the concern which they have expressed regarding the numerous problems now associated with the operation of ambulance services in Columbus County.

IT IS RESOLVED that this Board respectfully request each municipality to consider exercising the authority granted to municipalities by N. C. General Statute 153-9 (58b) and to consult with all rescue squads, funeral and ambulance services in Columbus County, and to submit to the Board of County Commissioners their recommendations regarding the numerous problems now presented by ambulance and emergency operations in Columbus County.

Upon motion made by Commissioner Williamson, seconded by Commissioner Burns, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

WHEREAS the 1967 General Assembly enacted in the law a provision of the N. C. General Statute 9-8 requiring the Board of County Commissioners to set up the fees of jurors, and

WHEREAS the maximum fee which the Board of County Commissioners pay jurors under said law is \$8.00 per day plus mileage at 5¢ per mile,

IT IS NOW THEREFORE RESOLVED and ordered that jurors in Columbus County shall be paid \$8.00 per day plus 5¢ per mile provided however, the compensation of jurors to pass upon competency of any person shall remain unchanged.

Ordered: that the late listing penalty charged in the name of W. H. Shelley, Jr. Chadbourn Township, be cancelled for the year 1967 due to a clerical error.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Alfred (Adford) Edwards, Cerro Gordo Township, be cancelled for the years 1929, 1931, and 1932 due to double listing.

ROAD PETITION: Bogue Township - Road known as the Nehemiah Powell Road. It is .3 miles in length and has 3 occupied homes on it.
