The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that William Freedman be reappointed as a director on the Southeastern Economic Development Commission for a term of one year.

Ordered: that the Sencland Community Action, Inc. be designated to be the Community Action Agency for Columbus County.

Ordered: that Edward W. Williamson be appointed to serve on the Welfare Board of Columbus County for a four year term.

Ordered: that a check in the amount of \$250 be written to the Cerro Gordo Rescue and Fire Dept.

Mr. C. D. Raper of the County Extension Office presented budget requests for the fiscal year 1968-1969.

Robert Dale Inman, surveyor, presented preliminary plans and maps of county property. Mr. Inman gave a complete report of all transactions of county property in the past. Completed maps, plans, etc., will be available within a few days from his office.

Mr. Phillip Comer, President, and Mr. William L. Eddins, Business Manager, of Southeastern Community College presented budget requests for the college for the fiscal year 1968-69.

The Chairman advised the Board he had received a letter from the Administrative Office of the Courts concerning salaries of employees in the Clerk's office effective December 2, 1968. At this time, according to the new court system which comes into effect, the state will assume all salaries. Mr. Lee J. Greer, CSC, came in to discuss this matter and the Board agreed to approve his recommendations which must be submitted to the state office.

Mr. Selby Hawk, District Forester, presented the budget request for the Fire Warden of Columbus County for the fiscal year 1968-69.

Ordered: that the valuation of \$1,400.00 be released from the 1964 tax lien listed in the name of J. P. and Kathleen Bell, Whiteville Township. The \$1,400.00 is to be figured on the 1967 tax rate which is \$1.49 per \$100 valuation as Mr. R. L. Faulk, now owner of this property, listed through error a trailer house valued at \$1,400 for the year 1967 in Bolton Township along with his other property and paid taxes due in Bolton Township for the year 1967, September 15, 1967. He requested that the \$20.86 release be applied to the 1964 taxes listed to J. P. and Kathleen Bell, Whiteville Township, Receipt # 3038.
