The following business was transacted:

A motion was made by Commissioner Watts and seconded by Commissioner Williamson that \$100 per month be appropriated for added expense incurred by the Deputy Judge of Recorders Court brought by the increased court sessions and related duties in overcoming the backlog of cases in Recorders Court.


Ordered: that S. Preston Douglas & Associates of Lumberton, N. C. be awarded the contract to audit the office of the Clerk of Superior Court for period beginning December 1, 1967 and ending November 30, 1968 at a rate of \$45 per day plus reasonable travel and subsistence expense for the services of each accountant engaged in work. The Chairman and Clerk were authorized to execute said contract in behalf of the Board of Commissioners.

Ordered: that Columbus County will participate in the "Cape Fear above Wilmington" navigation project for the fiscal year 1968-69 in the amount not to exceed \$1700.

Ordered: that the salary of W. A. Williams, Judge of Recorders Court of Columbus County, be terminated June 30, 1968 until such time as Judge Williams resumes his duties as Judge of Recorders Court.

Mr. Cecil Edwards, Health Department Sanitarian, appeared in behalf of Mr. Rhone Anderson and discussed the disposal of garbage in Columbus County. Mr. Edwards stated the need in Columbus County was great for the correct disposal of garbage and refuse and presented pictures to this effect from various areas of the county. Mr. Edwards also stated there were no complaints to his knowledge of the local garbage service at this time of which Mr. Anderson has a franchise of a 6-mile radius of Whiteville for the collection of garbage.

Ordered: that a letter be written to Edgar Soles, Whiteville, N. C. requesting him to cease and desist from the collection of garbage within a six-mile radius of Whiteville due to the franchise issued to Mr. Rhone Anderson for this area.



Ordered: that J. Hubert Norris be reappointed Tax Collector and R. Brooks Stanley reappointed Deputy Tax Collector. They are to continue services in the same manner as before.

Ordered: that Waccamaw Bank & Trust Company be named depository for the Undistributed Tax Fund, all school funds and Community College funds with the exception of the Current Expense Fund which will be deposited in Southern National Bank of North Carolina with all other county funds for the fiscal year 1968-69.

Ordered: that the personal property listed in the name of Edward Shipman, Whiteville Township, be cancelled for the year 1967 due to double listing.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of J. D. Ward, Whiteville Township, be cancelled for the years 1940 through 1967 due to double listing.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Javie Wilson, South Williams Township, be cancelled for the years 1961 through 1965 due to double listing. (Double listed to Grainger Motor Company).

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Walter Stephens, Tatum Township, be segregated so that Clifton Stephens be allowed to pay the taxes on one lot valved at \$90 for the years 1963 through 1966, and upon payment of above tax and a proportionate part of personal property, this one lot shall be free from tax liens for said years.
