Ordered: that Christmas Holidays for county employees begin on Tuesday, December 24th and that work will be resumed on Friday, December 27th.

Ordered: that the chairman and clerk be authorized to release the December salary checks of county employees December 20, 1968.

J. M. Powell, representative of the North Carolina Blue Cross and Blue Shield, Inc., appeared before the Board and discussed a new

proposed hospitalization plan for Columbus County employees. This proposal

would increase the monthly payment approximately 63%. Mr. Powell asked

the Board to review the proposal and notify him of their decision as to

whether Columbus County would remain on the present plan or accept the new proposed plan.

The Whiteville Merchants Association Board of Directors

appeared before the Board with Mr. Gene Sears as spokesman for the group
