RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the State Forestry Service is hereby requested to reconvey to Columbus County a small tract of land formerly deeded by the Town of Whiteville to the State Forestry Service for use in the Master Plan of the Columbus County Airport; and

WHEREAS, in exchange for said reconveyance, Columbus County will lease said tract back to the State Forestry Service for a period of 99 years for the sum of \$1.00 as rental; and

WHEREAS, in the event it becomes necessary in the development of the airport to move the Forestry hanger, Columbus County will make available to the Forestry Service another tract of land for the hanger and will move the hanger to the new location at no expense to the State Forestry Service.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that when the State Forestry Service reconveys this property to Columbus County, the County will give a 99 year lease and if it becomes necessary to move the hanger, the County will make available property and move the hanger at no expense to the State Forestry Service.

Mr. P. O. Gore, Treasurer of the Simmon's Bay Drainage Project, appeared before the Board to request assistance from the County in purchasing tile to construct a bridge at Gore Lake in Bug Hill Township, Columbus County. Mr. Gore stated the approximate cost of this tile was \$2,550.68 and that this is the only means of crossing this drainage canal and was very important for many property owners in this section.
