Collections as of January 31, 1970. Mr. Norris stated 78.6% of the 1969

tax receipts were collected as of this date; Riegelwood Sanitary District

collections reached 96.8% and \$47,967 in Drainage District taxes had been

collected. He further stated collection of back taxes were good.

Upon motion of Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Commissioner Gore, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

RESOLUTION CONCERNING REGIONAL PLANNING

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina has been administratively divided into fifteen regions; and

adjacent counties located in Region Ten; and

WHEREAS, Columbus County would be more compatibly aligned with the counties in Region Ten,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners does hereby petition and request the State Planning Division of the Department of Administration to reconsider its action announced on January 26, 1970, by rescinding that part of the document which placed Columbus County in Region Eleven and further that action be initiated to reposition Columbus County within the jurisdictional lines of Region Ten.
