Upon motion made and seconded, the minutes were read and approved for the April 20th meeting.

Ordered: that payment for fertilizer, lime and grass seed be made in the amount of \$534.16 to improve the Columbus County airport landing strip to prevent further deterioration. The forestry service will provide the necessary labor and machinery for the completion of this project which will be under the supervision of Mr. John T. Wilson, Chairman of the Airport Authority.

Mr. R. C. Soles, Sr., Chairman, Columbus County Planning Board and Mr. Rudolph Walters, Executive Director, Economic Bevelopment Commission brought the Board up to date concerning the progress that had been made toward getting the county zoned. Mr. Walters stated he had contacted Mr. George J. Monaghan, Administrator, Division of Community Planning of the Department of Local Affairs and was advised that this department would zone various sections of the county for a fee of \$3,000., and upon motion of Commissioner Gore, seconded by Commissioner Johnson and unanimously adopted that the county be zoned by the State Division of Community Planning and that Mr. George J. Monaghan be notified by letter and request that appropriate contracts be forwards to this office for execution.

Alice Wright, Social Services Director, and a member of the

Social Services Board presented the Administrative Budget for the Social

Services Department and reviewed the Public Assistance Budgets for the fiscal

year 1970-1971.

Dr. J. R. Black presented the budget request for the Co-Operative Health Department for the fiscal year 1970-71. Mr. C. W. Duggins, Supt. of Whiteville City Schools and Board Chairman Billy Hooks presented the budget request for the fiscal year 1970-71. Mr. Duggins stated this was an approximate increase of 18% to 20% over 1969-70 budget.

Sheriff Ben Duke requested the Board of Commissioners to notify the Fifth Judicial District Planning Unit that Columbus County would like to be able to purchase equipment through this organization.

Miss Elaine Von Oesen, Asst. State Librarian, Mr. Tony Leggette, and Miss Alice Lowe appeared before the Board to discuss the requirements Columbus County Library would have to meet before state assistance could be applied for. It was stated by Miss Von Oesen that requirement should be met and budget figures submitted to the State Library Board by September 30, to receive assistance this fiscal year. It was confirmed by Miss Von Oesen that according to records in the office of the State Library Board, all terms of the present County Library Board had expired in 1964. Upon discussion it was recommended by the group present that due to health conditions and abilities of some of the present board members, that they would like to recommend that a new library Board be appointed. The Commissioners then asked the group for recommendations of interested persons from various sections of the county so they might be considered in appointment of a new library board. After a lengthy discussion, the following action was taken: Upon motion of Commission Gore, seconded by Commissioner Williamson and unanimously adopted that the following persons be appointed to serve on the county library board for the following terms:
