The minutes of the January 4th meeting were read and approved.

Colonel Walters, Executive Director of Economic Development Commission, met with the Board to discuss plans for making applications for federal funds for paving the county airport. A motion was made by Commissioner Watts, seconded by Commissioner Burns, and unanimously adopted as follows: Colonel Walters is hereby designated the proper spokesman for Columbus County to federal, state, and county agencies, and all other information pertaining to application for assistance in paving the Columbus County Airport. All other motions made by this Board before, designating groups, individuals, or organizations as representatives or spokesman in said matter, or in conflict with this motion are hereby rescinded. It is further ordered that the Chairman of this Board shall be authorized to sign letters regulating the airport proposals deemed proper and necessary by Colonel Walters.

ROAD PETITION: Cerro Gordo Township - This road is leading North to the old Mt. Moriah Church. It is .2 miles in length and has 5 occupied homes located on it.

Ordered: that the poll tax listed in the name of Douglas R. Marlowe, Whiteville Township, be released for the year 1970 due to double listing.

Ordered: that five additional names be added to the American/Bicentennial Committee and also replace Mrs. Carl Meares, who was unable to serve at this time. Those added are:

Ordered: that the clerk write a letter to Mr. Miller O. Gore acknowledging the letter received by this Board concerning his request for consideration for veterans.
