The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that Mr. E. M. Griffin, Building Supervisor, be in charge of painting the outside of the Columbus County Library. Also, the remodeling in the Food Stamp Dept. in the County Hall which has already been underway is to be supervised by Mr. Griffin. He is to buy any materials that are needed to finish the remodeling and approve the bills to be paid. The purchases already made are approved for payment at this time and are to be charged to the Social Services Budget as there will be a higher percentage of federal participation in some catagories than anticipated at budget time.

Ordered: that Lois Jacobs be given a check for \$25.00 from the Out-Door-Poor Fund.

Ordered: that the Board of Education be allowed to transfer funds within their budget as they deem necessary due to more funds available than was anticipated within certain items.

Ordered: that the following taxes be released upon the recommendation of the Office of the Tax Supvr.:

Taxes listed in the name of H. Howard Cartrette, South Williams Township, be reduced in the amount of \$108.00 for the year 1971 due to a clerical error.

The following were reappointed jointly by the Board of Commissioners, Resident Judge and Clerk of Superior Court: John L. Ward, Asa Reeves and H. L. Jordan. Each member will be notified by the Clerk to the Board of this action.

Ordered: that the Sheriff be in charge of ordering uniforms, keeping records, and approving bills for same in the amount of the budget set up for uniforms for this fiscal year.

Ordered: that the Chairman be authorized to sigh the Deed of Correction made to Whiteville Development Corp., dated 9/1/71 which is a correction for the deed transferring five acres of land to same 5/3/71.

The following resolution was unanimously adopted by the Board upon makings motion of Commissioner Burns, seconded by Commissioner Johnson:

WHEREAS, the Commission by resolution adopted on July 19, 1971, agreed to form the Columbus County Pollution Abatement and Industrial Facilities Authority (the Authority"); and

WHEREAS, Riegel Paper Corporation has stated its intentions to construct at its Riegelwood, N. C. mill a new facility to meet new pollution standards (the "Project"), if suitable arrangements can be made with the Autéhority;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that this Commission shall use its best efforts to (1) expedite the formation of the Authority, (2) assist the Authority, when duly organized and authorized, in entering into appropriate lease arrangements for the Project with Riegel Paper Corporation as lessee.

Mr. Billy Graham, from the FLB Office asked the Commissioners to adopt the following resolution and forward a copy to Congressman Alton Lennon stating their approval of same:

WHEREAS, the Columbus County Board of Commissioners is keenly aware of the financial assistance rendered to this Nation's agriculture by the Land Bank System since its inception in 1916; and

WHEREAS, they recognize the contribution and progress of the American farmer in making this Nation the best fed at less cost to the consumer than any Nation on earth;

WHEREAS, they further recognize that today's farmers need larger amounts of capital and the dire need of updating the Land Bank Laws to enable the system to more effectively provide this credit,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Columbus County Board of Commissioners fully support and endorse the "Farm Credit Act of '71" as introduced in the United States Senate and House of Representatives.

The aboveresolution was unanimously adopted by the Board of Commissioners, upon motion by Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Commissioner Burns.

Mr. Raymond Shaw, Member of Columbus County Policy Advisory Council, brought several complaints before the Board concerning the Food Stamp Program service and asked the Board to investigate them.

Mr. Hugh Clark, Radford Allen, District Supervisor of F.H.A., and Cecil Edwards, from the County Health Dept., came to discuss the future plans of the Board concerning the Solid Waste Disposal Program for Columbus County. Mr. Allen offered any assistance his agency could give in financing this operation when the Board wanted to accept.
