The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office at 10:00 a.m., June 5, 1972, it being first Monday.

The meeting was called to order and the following business was transacted:

Mr. Bill Floyd from Floyd's Insurance Agency came to review insurance coverage on county buildings and some adjustments were made. Mr. Floyd is to revise the policy and send a copy to the Clerk to keep on file.

A delegation from the A-D Rescue Squad came to reinstate their earlier request to the Board for improvement of emergency service in the county, as there had been no action taken on their request.

Mr. Steve Whitacre again met with the Board with revisions in the schedule as requested by the Board. Due to the fact that all members of the Board were not present, a motion was made by Commissioner Watts, seconded by Commissioner Gore and carried not to take any action on the proposed schedule until all members of the Board are present. Commissioner Burns did not vote.

The Budget was presented for the Mental Health Center by Mr. Marchinko, Dr. Douglas, and Mr. McKee. No action was taken on the request at this meeting. There was a discussion with the representatives concerning various phases of the request.

The Budget for the County Extension Service was presented by Mr. C. D. Raper, Extension Chairman, for the Fy 1972-73. Mr. Raper asked for an additional secretary in the new proposed Budget which was granted upon a motion made by Commissioner Burns and seconded by Commissioner Watts. No other decisions were made at this time.

Mr. Raper also presented a program funded by the Federal Government which would be jointly operated in Columbus and Brunswick Counties. The Board voted unanimously to allow Mr. Raper to participate in this program at no cost to the county.

Ordered: that the poll tax and laterlisting penalty in the name of Jimmy Wayne

Fowler, Williams Township, be released for the year 1971 due to depicaliering.

Upon motion made by Commissioner Watts, seconded by Commissioner Burns, and un-

animously padsed by those present that the Board recognize and endorse the CApe Fear Health

Planning Council as the regional comperhensive health planning agency for Region "O" of which Columbus County is a member.

The following resolution was unanimously passed by the Board and forwarded to the Cape Fear Council of Governments:

WHEREAS, Columbus County recognizes the need to improve housing conditions to achieve a higher standard of living for all of its citizens; and WHEREAS, Columbus County wishes to have a balanced community developemnt program, Columbus County hereby resolves to incorporate the following housing goals into its overall development program:

1. To substantially reduce the number of people living in substandard and overcrowded housing.

2. To make standard housing available for people of all income ranges.

3. To improve the quality of residential enviroment.

4. To establish a mechanism for measuring and meeting future housing needs.

5. To improve housing choice in terms of the types of housing available as well as location.

6. To reduce the cost of housing, consistant with sound planning and construction practices.

There was a general discussion concerning the School Budget for FY 1972-73. After the discussion the Clerk was instructed to inform the Board of Education to resubmit a budget with a tax levy of \$1.0830 with other factors as follwos: Valuation to be used is \$144,000,000; 86% rate of tax collection; \$100,000.00 local 1% sales tax. Upon the suggestion of Commissioner Gore the Clerk was instructed to request that out of these funds lights are to be installed at Nakina High School Ball Field during the coming FY.
