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The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office at 10:00 a.m., June 4, 1973 it being first Monday.

The meeting was called to order and the following business was transacted; after the invocation was given by the Reverend O'Ferrall Thompson, Grace Episcopal Church, Whiteville:

Several members of the Columbus County Red Cross Committee, with Mrs. Norman Peal as spokesman, came before the Board and made a request for \$6,000 to help meet the quota of funds to be raised by Columbus County. The Committee plans to establish a blood bank in the County and this quota must be met before they can proceed further with the plans. A motion was made by Commissioner Buffkin, seconded by Commissioner Burns that the Board approves the secureing of a blood bank and upon the receipt of further information, will render assistance if possible.

Ordered: that the Clerk contact Mr. John McKee, Southeastern Regional Mental Health Center, concerning making application for State funds for the building of office speak for the Mental Health Personnel in Columbus County. Mr. Brown had received information that State funds could be secured on an 82% basis, with the County contributing the balance.

Ordered: that Mr. Rhone Anderson be hired as supervisor of the Sanitary Landfill and Rural Garbage Collection. His beginning salary will be \$100.00 per week beginning July 1, 1973. Mr. Anderson is authorized to hire four additional employees to provide the necessary services to operate the Landfill and Collection Program.

Ordered: thatta letter be writter by the Clerk to the Town of Chadbourn informing them of the approval of the Board of the appointment of Jasper Hoover and Edgar Mincher as alternate members of the Planning and Zoning Board of Adjustments for the Town of Chadbourn.

Ordered: that the Clerk request further information on the property deeded to the Town of Chadbourn by Mid State Homes on which the Town of Chadbourn has requested the County to release the taxes.

Ordered: that Mr. Stanley be designated to answer the letter from Wallace Clontz, Commissioner, Town of Tabor City, on his complaints about the low valuation of the property in the Town of Tabor City.

Ordered: that Columbus County accept the Emergency Employment Funds from the State to carry out a summer program if the Board of Education will provide supervision for the program. All funds are to be provided by the State.

Ordered: that Columbus County approve the application of Southeastern Community College for a Project Grant for Older Americans, with contributions not to exceed \$755.50 for local support for said Project if it is finalized. This Project is to be funded by New Hanover, Pender, Brunswick and Columbus Counties on the local level.

Ordered: that upon the recommendation of the Tax Supervisor, that the taxes listed in the name of Cliff Willie Rouse & Wife, South Williams Township, be cancelled for the years 1970, 1971, and 1972 due to double listing.

Ordered: that upon the recommendation of the Tax Collector, a refund be made to Peoples Savings & Loan Association, Whiteville Township, in the amount of \$381.46 for taxes paid through error in the name of Columbus Cemetary Park Corp, Whiteville Township. The receipt was returned to the Tax Collector's Office for a refund.

Mr. J. K. Powell, Attorney for National Spinning Co., came before the Board again to seek further consideration for National Spinning Co. concerning the valuation of their property in Columbus County. The Board will notify Mr. Powell if there is further change.

Mrs. Helma English and Mrs. Marvaneen Davis, representing the FAmily Planning Re-Sources, Inc., came to give information on the establishing of the Corporation and asked the Board to endorse their efforts. A motion was made by Commissioner Buffkin, seconded by Commissioner Burns and unanimously passed to endorse the program and to send a statement to Mr. Schmidt, Region "O" Planner, veryfying their support.

Mr. George Holt, President, and E. L. Williamson, Attorney, for Columbus National Bank, requested the Board to deposit some of the County's Funds in the Columbus National Bank. The Board stated they would consider their request but no decision was made at this time.

Mrs. Wright requested the Board to include in the Social Services Administrative Budget a designated amount to pay hospital insurance for the Social Services Department. This request will be considered when the Board meets to review the proposed budget.
