

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office at 10:00 a.m., July 2, 1973, it being first Monday.

The meeting was called to order and the invocation was given by the Reverend Sidney Oxendine, Union Valley Baptist Church.

The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that R. Brooks Stanley be reappointed as Tax Supervisor for two years.

Ordered: that E. M. Griffin be reappointed to serve as Tax Collector for one year.

Ordered: that the County Building Inspector be authorized to work out a plan jointly with the FHA Office to complete the first two inspection reports which is now being duplicated by both offices.

Ordered: that the following releases be made upon the recommendation of the Tax Supvr.:

that the taxes listed in the name of All Star Homes, Welches Creek Township, be released in the valuation of \$1996 for the years 1965, 1966, 1967, 1968, 1969, 1970, 1971, and 1972 due to an error in listing.

that the 1971 taxes listed in the name of Donna G. Grainger Heirs, Lees Township, be released in the value of \$1580 due to a house burning.

that the taxes listed in the name of Jason T. Long, Lees Township, be cancelled for the years 1968, 1969, 1970, and 1971 due to double listing.

Ordered: that the following tax release be made upon the recommendation of the Tax Collector: that the 1970 taxes listed in the name of Elnora McCoy Graham, Ransom Township, be cancelled in the amount of \$3.99 due to double listing.

Mr Rhone Anderson and Mr. Steve Ammons came to discuss the building of a road into the proposed landfill site. There were two plans discussed; one, the Board of Commissioner could seek funds from the State through the Secondary Roads Funds at no cost to the County, or, two, the County could hire the State to build the road on a reimburseable cost basis. The Clerk was instructed to contact Mr. N. S. Day, Division Engineer, to request funds from the Secondary Roads Funds.

A group of citizens from the Hallsboro School Community came to request the Board to assist them in replacing the sports equipment lost in a fire which partially destroyed the Hallsboro Gym. The Board made no commitments at this time.

Mrs. Marie Suggs & Mr. Don Veits came to again request the Board for funds to help establish a blood bank for Columbus County through the Red Cross Chapter in the County. The County Attorney stated he knew of no legal channel that the Board could donate funds to a Charitable organization.

The Budget was discussed further and the Auditor was instructed to appropriate \$200,000. additional funds from Revenue Sharing Funds to the schools on a per capita basis to be used for Capital Outlay Expenditures. Also, \$12,500 is to be appropriated out of Revenue Sharing Funds to be used to finance a Soil Survey Inventory. Mr. Yates of the Soil Conservation Service is to draft plans for the Survey.
