The meeting was called to order and the invocation was given by The Reverand Sparks.

The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that the bids for the renovation of the Ward Building be opened on December 12, 1973, at 2:30.

Ordered: that \$18,437.50 be included in the 1974-75 Budget as the County's share of an armory to be in the Whiteville area. The toatl cost is to be \$ 295,000 which is 75% federal funds and $12\frac{1}{2}$ City of Whiteville.

Ordered: that a meeting be set to meet with the Division Engineer, D. W. Patrick, and Secondary Roads Councilman, Sameul Stephenson on December 10th at 2:00 p.m. This request was made by Mr. Mills, District Engineer.

Ordered: that the motion passed at the November 19,1973, be amended to charge a \$2.00 tax on all dogs, whether male or female.

Mr. Allen Price, CPA, presented a copy of the audit for the year ending June 30, 1973, to each member of the Board to review and prepare questions to be discussed at a later date. Mr. Price gave a brief statement to the Board stating that Columbus County's overall financial picture is in good order and funds had been handled with honesty and fidelity during the year. He made a suggestion to improve the operation of the new uniform system was to consider replacing the present posting machine.

Ordered: that the following tax releases be made upon the recommendation of the Tax Supervior's Office:

That the 1973 taxes listed in the name of Leabanon Lodge #207, Whiteville Township, be released on the valuation of \$11520 due to Masoniz Lidge exemption.

That the taxes listed in the name of Mattie C. Freeman, Bolton Township, be released for the years 1963 through 1973 due to double listing.

Ordered: that the Elections Board Budget be amended by line items as follows: Salaries & Wages \$975.00; Non Professional Salaries - \$1,000.00 amd Travel - \$250.00. This increase was needed because of an election that was not anticipated at the time the Budget was adopted.

At Twelve O'clock the Chairman announced that it was time to elect a Chairman and Vice-Chairman for the ensuing year. He immediately stated that he was stepping down as Chairman. A motion was made by Commissioner Williamson to nominate Donald P. Currie to serve as Chairman and Mayo Brown as Vice-Chairman. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Buffkin, and unanimously passed. All Board members commended Commissioner Williamson for a job well done

and expressed pleasure for their past year working together.

A motion was made by Commissioner Buffkin to re-appoint all County Employees for another year, but received no second.

A motion was made and seconded to adjourn for lunch.

Chairman Currie called the meeting to order after lunch recess and the following business was transacted:

A motion was made by Commissioner Buffkin to re-appoint all County employees to work at the will of the Board and Surety Bonds were approved as filed in the office of the Clerk of Court. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Williamson and duly passed.

Ordered: that the Clerk to the Board be reappointed and the County Attorney be retained to work at the will of the Board.

Ordered: that the Clerk write a letter to Representative R. C. Soles, Jr., Member of the House Finance Committee, requesting him to support and vote for a favorable report for House Bill #529 which concerns Automobile taxes for counties. A copy of this request is to be sent to other Representatives and Senator serving this district.

Ordered: that Paul Hughes be made assistant Building Supervisor in addition to Building Custodian and that his salary be increased to 525.00 per month, beginning on 12-1-73.

Ordered: That J. T. Bethea be hired as Janitor ato assist Mr. Hughes at a salary of \$416.00 per month.

Ordered: that the salary of Helen Bethea be increased \$25.00 per month beginning December 1, 1973.

Ordered: that Joyce Ransom be hired as a permanent employee upon the request of E. M. Griffin, Tax Collector, at a salary of \$414.00 per month.

Ordered: that the Chairman be authorized to sign the agreement to continue receiving Emergency Employment Funds for the employment of the present Soil Technician.

Ordered: that the Chairman be allowed to designate a person to act in lieu of the Chairman to supervise prisoners assigned to work under the direction of the County Commissioners. Chairman Currie appointed Commissioner Williamson to assume this responsibility.

Mr. Stanley, Tax Supervisor, presented the late tax listings to the Board for the month of November to be filed with the Clerk to the Board.

Ordered: that the general county bills be allowed and paid listed on pages 85,886% 87.

Upon motion the meeting adjourned until Mondays December 10, 1973, at 2:00 p.m., to meet with Department of Transportation Officials to discuss the new rules and regulations set up under the present administration in Raleigh.
