Ordered: that J. M. Spaulding be appointed to replace Mr. Jack Council as a member of the Columbus County Airport Authority. Mr. Council has moved out of the County.

Upon motion by Commissioner Burns, seconded by Commissioner Brown and unanimously passed, the bid was given to The News Reporter Co., Inc., Whiteville, N. C.

Ordered: that the following taxes be released upon the recommendation of the Tax Supervisor: That the taxes listed in the name of John W. & Martha Mathews, Whiteville Township, be released on the valuation of \$2028 due to being in Domcil, Florida in service.

Ordered: that the 1973 taxes listed in the name of Lucy Ford, Whiteville Township, be cancelled due to double listing Lucy Ford.

Ordered: that the 1972 taxes listed in the name of James Foster George, Whiteville Township, be cancelled due to double listing.

Ms. Elizabeth Covington met with the Board to request more office space for the Mental Health Clinic due to an increase in staff and patients. The proposal as presented would cost \$17,920.00. No action was taken at this time.

The procedures for processing road petitions was discussed as set out by the DOT.

Road petition for Road #1729 was forwardeds to the Department of Transportation for processing.

Mr. Reg Braxton from Motorola, Inc. presented a plan to the Board to set up a comm-

munications mystem for the Landfill, Dog Warden and Sanitarians. The cost of the system installed would be \$9,249.22. No action was taken on the proposal at this time.

District Court Judge, Ray Walton, appeared before the Board and requested that the Board designate \$1,500.00 per year from Facilities Fees to establish a Law Library in the Courts house. This request will be taken under consideration at a later meeting.

Mr. Terry Frye presented a demonstration of a Burroughs computer that could be used in county offices for tax billing and accounting. Also present was Mr. Felix Cooper, LGC, who specializes in advising counties on purchasing machines. There was a discussion on the capabilities of the computer and the need the county has for upgrading its present system of record keeping. The Board asked Mr. Cooper to look further into other machines available and report to the Board at a later time.
