AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO GRANT AGREEMENT FOR PROJECT NO. 7-37-0081-01

WHEREAS, the Federal Aviation Administration (hereinafter referred to as the "FAA") has determined it to be in the interest of the United States that the Grant Agreement between the FAA, acting for and on the behalf of the United States, and the County of Columbus, North Carolina (hereinafter referred to as the Sponsor), accepted by said Sponsor on August 9, 1971, as amended by Amendment No. 1 be further amended as hereinafter provided.

NOW THEREFORE WITNESSETH:

That, in consideration of the benefits to accrue to the parties hereto, the FAA on behalf of the United States, on the one part, and the Sponsor, on the other part, do hereby mutually agree that the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement between the United States and the Sponsor, accepted by said Sponsor on August 9, 1971, as amended by Amendment No. 1, be further amended as follows:

1. The maximum obligation of the United States payable under the Grant is increased by \$9,664.95 from \$149,298 to \$158,962.95.

It is understood and agreed that all the other terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as amended, remain in full force and effect and are not changed or altered except as hereinabove provided.

The United States shall not be obligated under any provision hereof unless this Amendment has been executed by the Sponsor on or before December 31, 1974, or such subsequent date as may be prescribed in writing by the Administrator.

Ordered: that the Chairman be authorized to sign the necessary documents to allow the Hospital to obtain a loan from FHA which will include extending the lease to the Trustees.

The Clerk was instructed to contact other counties and obtain copies of their annual leave schedule, sick leave and other regulations concerning working time.

The Clerk was instructed to contact the Retirement System and request an official of their office to meet with the Board and discuss the new retirement laws and benefits passed by the 1974 General Assambley.

There was a general discussion concerning the purchase of property by the County for a Day Care Center for exceptional childred. The Board instructed Mr. Robinson, County Attorney to proceed with the purchase of the Baldwin Property.

Bids were opened for the purchase of oil for the County Buildings for heat and the Solid Waste Department for their vehicles and recorded as follows:
