The following business was transacted:

Ordered: that the tax levy for dogs, either male or female, be set at \$3.00 each for the tax year 1975. (Voting YES were Williamson, Brown, & Marlowe. NO was Buffkin)

Ordered: that the Clerk finalize appointments with the Board at closing time on Thursday preceeding Monday meetings, except for emergencies, and mail a copy of the agenda to each Board Member on Friday. The Clerk is further ordered to mail each Board Member a copy of the minutes of the proceeding meeting.

Ordered: that the Accountant be authorized to pay Food Stamp Eligibility Specialist overtime for all hours in excess of 40 hrs. per week through January 31st. State and Federal Revenue is to be increased 75% of the cost and County Surplus 25%.

Ordered: that the following tax releases be made upon the recommendation of the Tax Supervisor:

No further business was transacted, but the following items were discussed.

Mr. Rhone Anderson requested a Budget increase for equipment; i.e., a used dragline and truck to be used for a back-up truck when other vehicles are out of service. No action was taken at this meeting.

DOT District Engineer, B. A. Mills and a group of Evergreen citizens, with John Graham as spokesman, appeared before the Board to request that improvements be made in the drainage of SR#1574 (Old #4). At the suggestion of Mr. Mills, he and Mr. Yates, Soil Conservation Dept., will visit the road to determine the deficiency and suggest the appropriate action to be taken.

Mr. Maurice Hobbs, Chairman, Riegelwood Sanitary District, presented a resolution to the Board for their consideration to participate in the 201 Facilities Plan for the Northeastern part of the County. Should the County participate, they would be obligated to fund a portion of the cost of the plan. No action was taken at this meeting.

Representative-elect O. Richard Wright, Jr. and Senator-elect Edd Nye met with the Board to discuss proposed legislation which would affect local governments in the upcoming General Assembly. The Board assured the members of their support and cooperation.

Mr. Allen Price, CPA, presented the annual audit report for the FY ending June 30, 1974, and declared the County's financial condition to be in excellent condition at that time. He suggested the Board review the report and invite him to a later meeting if they had questions they wished to discuss.

Mr. Donald Slopp, U. S. Dept. of Labor, briefed the Board on the U. S. Dept. of Labor Laws which will become effective on January 1, 1975 in regard to policemen. There was a discussion which followed with the following persons present: E. J. Elkins, Chairman, PSC; Jesse R. Barker, County Police Chief; John Coleman, Sheriff; and members of the Police Dept. The Public Safety Commission Chairman is to meet with the Board on first Monday in January to present a recommendation from that Board as to the best plan to follow.

Upon motion the meeting adjourned until 10:00 a.m., January 16, 1975.
