The meeting was called to order by the Chairman and there was further discussion of the budget estimate.

A motion was made by Commissioner Dew, seconded by Commissioner McPherson and tentative passed to prepare the budget estimate at a 90% collection rate of taxes and based on \$370,000 valuation, with the levy to remain the same as 1977-78. (\$1.20) Commissioner Hinson opposed the motion and stated that he was willing to raise taxes to include the water management and mosquito control program.

The above estimate would give the Schools Current Expense and Capital Outlay budget estimate an increase of 7.2% above the budget appropriation for 1977-78 from the General Fund.

Upon motion the meeting adjourned until May 31, 1978, to interview applicants for the position of Supervisor of the Water Management and Mosquito Control Program. The meeting will convene at 7:30 p.m.
