

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office at 11:00 a.m., Monday, January 14, 1980, in a special called meeting according to notice posted as required by G. S. 153A-40.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman and the following business was transacted:

Mrs. Bobbie DeWitt, CETA Coordinator, was present at the meeting to inform the Board of the present status of CETA slots that are available to Columbus County for employment at this time. She stated that there are 15 slots available on Title II-D and one on Title VI. There are also two vacancies on the Title VI Project at the Library. She also stated that slots that become vacant may be replaced until further instructions from the State CETA Office. There was a discussion of the needs of various agencies that have requested CETA slots and the following assignments were made:

Title II-D - One slot to each of the agencies listed below:

The Board agreed to allow each agency to replace any vacancy that occurs in their respective agency until further instructions from the State CETA Office. Also, it was agreed that Commissioners Dew and Williamson screen the applicants for the positions that will be employed by a County Department. The Town of Cerro Gordo and the Miller Building were given top priority for a slot when additional slots become available. All previous slot assignments are voided by the above action.

A motion was made by Commissioner Dew, seconded by Commissioner Hinson and passed that Commissioners Williamson and McPherson be appointed to continue to serve on the Council of Governments General Membership Commission.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hinson, seconded by Commissioner Williamson and passed to appoint Otto Nance to serve as electrical inspector in the Chadbourn area to replace Mr. William McArthur, who is deceased. He is now serving as the "at large" inspector which he will continue to do in addition to the Chadbourn area.

By the same motion Mr. Rilley Powell was appointed to serve the Whiteville area as electrical inspector. He replaces Mr. John Anderson who is deceased.

Both appointments are subject to their being qualified and certified by the State Department of Insurance.

The following motion was passed upon motion by Commissioner McPherson and seconded by Commissioner Hinson:
