Also present, were approximately fifty (50) Columbus County citizens.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman.

The Chairman requested the Commissioners and the Department of Transportation introduce themselves to the public.

Lenwood Rich, DOT Representative, thanked the Board for their attendance and presented them with the proposed 1983-84 Secondary Road Construction Proposal.

The State allocation for Columbus County for 1983-84 is tentatively set for \$644,301.00.

E. J. Butler and Lenwood Rich, DOT Representatives, explained the priority system was based on a point system and the list was updated every two years.

Robert Crumpler, District Engineer, read the 1983-84 priority listing to the public and the amount of funds that are to be expended on each State Road number. Mr. Crumpler requested the Board's consideration for a adopting a Resolution if they agreed with the proposal.

Lenwood Rich, DOT Representative, advised the public that each person who wished to be heard, concerning a road, raise their hand and they would be allowed to speak.

The Chairman, speaking for the Board, commended Robert Crumpler for the corporation he has given the County and improvement of roads since he became District Engineer with the Department of Transportation.

Commissioner Norris informed the public that a Commissioner is not a member of the Efficiency Council and Governor Jim Hunt made the appointments to the Council. He also stated that the Board has requested a copy of the minutes of their meetings to enable the Commissioners to review the recommendations before their meeting dates.

With no other persons wishing to be heard, a motion was made by Commissioner Dew, seconded by Commissioner Norris and passed unanimously to adopt a Resolution for the Tentative Secondary Road Construction Program for Fiscal Year 1983-84 as proposed by the Department of Transportation as follows:

#### R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Columbus County Board of Commissioners met with officials of the North Carolina Department of Transportation at a public hearing on June 13, 1983.

WHEREAS, the purpose of this meeting was to present to the public a Secondary Road Construction Program for fiscal year 1983-84 from the Department of Transportation as follows:

2	1924	Improve typical section and strengthen pavement on SR 1924 from NC 130 to SR 1001--1.7 miles. Estimated cost-----\$51,000.00

4	1800	Replace bridge number 251 with pipe on SR 1800. Estimated cost-----\$25,000.00
5	1004	Replace bridge number 132 with pipe on SR 1004. Estimated cost-----\$21,000.00
6	1730	Survey, right of way acquisition, grade, drain, base and pave SR 1730 (Priority #5--1981-83) from 2.0 miles southwest of SR 1735 to 1.0 mile southwest--1.0 mile. Estimated cost----\$100,000.00
7	1906	Survey and right of way acquisition on SR 1906 (Priority #4) from SR 1904 to US 74-76--1.1 miles. Estimated cost-----\$5,000.00
8	1808	Survey, right of way acquisition, grade, drain, base and pave SR 1808 (Priority #5) from SR 1740 to SR 1864. Also, replace bridge number 256 with pipe--1.9 miles. Estimated cost----\$210,000.00
9	1320	Survey, right of way acquisition, grade, drain, and stabilize SR 1320 (Priority #6) from US 701 to SR 1321--1.4 miles. (Note: Additional funds to be added later.) Estimated cost-----\$86,000.00
10	New Addition	Survey and right of way acquisition on 4 roads in Green Acres Subdivision--1.6 miles. Estimated cost-----\$5,000.00  Stabilization of various unpaved secondary roads (15% allocation). Estimated cost-----\$96,646.00  Reserve for road additions, overdrafts, surveys, contingencies, etc. Estimated cost-----\$12,655.00

If rights of way are not available on the above listed projects, the monies will be re-programmed on additional projects in accordance with the priority list.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Columbus County Board of Commissioners do hereby approve the Secondary Road Construction Program for Fiscal Year 1983-84 as stated above.
