COLUMBUS COUNTY CAPITAL OUTLAY - BLUE RIBBON COMMITTEE REPORT

Mr. Carl Ray, Chairman of the Columbus County Blue Ribbon Capital Outlay Committee, presented the Board with the Blue Ribbon Capital Outlay report and recognized Committee members in attendance as follows: Willard Small, Vice Chairman, Jim Blackman, Henry Edmund, James Furman Holcomb, Ladeen Powell and Roy L. Lowe, ex-officio member.

Committee members absent were: Kenneth Hawes, Viola Jacobs, Pete Duncan and Clarence Willoughby.

Mr. Roy L. Lowe, County Administrator and Capital Outlay ex-officio committee member, read aloud the summarization of the report.

The Chairman thanked the Capital Outlay Committee Members for their participation and dedication in doing the study for the County.

A motion was made by Commissioner Norris, seconded by Commissioner Byrd and passed unanimously to accept the report as presented by the Committee Members.

Chairman Koonce allowed anyone in attendance to comment on the report. There was a general discussion among County School, City School and Southeastern Community College officials concerning the report and they requested a bond referendum be limited to school needs only, outlined at a cost of \$19.2 million dollars in the report.

The Chairman advised the school officials that if they were in support of a bond referendum for the schools needs to endorse the referendum by presenting a unified Resolution from the three (3) school systems in support of the bond referendum to the Board of County Commissioners.

The Chairman stated that he would like to see the various Boards including, the Columbus County School Board, Whiteville City School Board, Southeastern Community College Board, Blue Ribbon Capital Outlay Committee and the Columbus County Board of Commissioners meet and study the report and come up with something sellable to the citizens of Columbus County.




