SOLID WASTE - AMENDMENT to ADDENDUM to AGREEMENT BETWEEN COLUMBUS COUNTY and WASTE MANAGEMENT of THE CAROLINAS, INCORPORATED:

Billy Joe Farmer, County Administrator, requested Board approval of the following amended Addendum to the Agreement between Columbus County and Waste Management of The Carolinas, Incorporated.

Addendum to Agreement between Columbus County and Waste Management of The Carolinas, Inc.

THIS	ADDENDUM mad	le and ente	ered into this	day o	f,	2004, by	and

"County") and	d Waste Managemen	nt of the Ca	arolinas, Inc. (("Contractor")).		

WHEREAS, the County put out a Request for Proposal (the "RFP") for companies to provide solid waste collection services in unincorporated portions of the County; and

WHEREAS, Contractor subject to this addendum is awarded the right to provide the solid waste collection services as set forth in the RFP; and

WHEREAS, the RFP contained the details of an agreement (the "Agreement") between the parties for the provision of those solid waste collection services (the "Services"); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Agreement to clarify the respective obligations and requirements therein.

- 1. Terms used herein but not defined herein shall have the meaning set forth in the Agreement.
 - 2. The following additional definitions shall apply to this Addendum:

"Approved Containers" shall mean Roll Out Carts and Bags (when a customer's Roll Out Cart is full due to excess volume and such Bags are placed adjacent to or on top of the Roll Out Cart).

"Bags" shall mean plastic sacks designed to store and enclose Municipal Solid Waste with sufficient wall strength to maintain physical integrity when lifted by top. Total weight of a bag with contents shall not exceed forty (40) pounds.

"Roll Out Cart" shall mean a Contractor owned receptacle with two wheels and a properly designed axle and fittings, and a top lid that is to remain closed except when loading waste, with a body consisting of approximately ninety (90) gallons in capacity, constructed of heavy duty plastic and having the strength to store normal household Municipal Solid Waste and equipped with proper attachments for hydraulic loading into the Contractor's collection vehicle.

- 3. Notwithstanding anything in the Agreement to the contrary:
- a. The Contractor shall not commence the Services before 5:30 a.m. each day. The Contractor may perform the Services on all weekdays and Saturdays. In special cases where the Contractor needs to work on Sunday, it shall first obtain written permission from the County Manager or his/her designee. Exceptions to collection hours shall be effected only upon the approval of the County Manager or his/her designee.
 - b. The following holidays may be observed by the Contractor:

New Year's Day Labor Day

Martin Luther King Day
Memorial Day
Thanksgiving Day
Christmas Day

Independence Day

The Contractor may decide to observe any or all of the above-mentioned holidays by suspension of the Services on the holiday provided said pickup is completed within 48 hours of the observed Holiday. The County herein agrees that the Contractor may not be able to provide Services on other days when the approved transfer station facility is closed. In the event said holiday is observed, notification by the contractor to the county of such intentions shall be made at least seven (7) calendar days in advance.

- 4. The parties understand and agree that, in the event of a storm, other inclement weather, or any unforeseen event resulting in excessive amounts of storm debris (including materials that might otherwise be classified as "yard waste") or other similar materials, the collection and disposal of such materials must be governed by a separate, written agreement to be negotiated by the parties. The County shall give the Contractor the first right and opportunity to enter such negotiations with the County, and both parties agree to conduct such negotiations in good faith. Columbus County reserves the right to contract with others to expedite the cleanup.
- 5. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Agreement, the Contractor shall not be required to collect, transport, dispose of or otherwise handle materials that are not Municipal Solid Waste or that are Excluded Waste, Hazardous Waste or Unacceptable Waste as defined by N.C.G.S. 130-A.

- 6. All waste collected by the Contractor in conjunction with the Services shall be disposed of by the Contractor at the Columbus County Transfer Station in Whiteville, North Carolina.
- 7. Except for those residents described in Section 4.2 of the Agreement, Approved Containers shall be placed in a location that is readily accessible to the Contractor and its collection equipment, not to exceed three (3) feet from the curb or on state road or edge of the traveled portion of the street or road and not to be located in a manner that will block the driveway or mailbox or otherwise inhibit proper servicing. The County will aid the Contractor in resolving problems of roll out cart location. In rural areas, if applicable, pickups will be limited to mailbox locations.
- 8. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Agreement, the contractor shall give all customer complaints prompt and courteous attention. In the case of an alleged missed scheduled collection, the Contractor shall investigate and if such allegations are verified, shall arrange for collection within Twenty Four (24) hours of the time the complaint was received. The Solid Waste Director shall be notified by the contractor of the outcome of the contractor's investigation within 24 hours of receiving such from the County.
- 9. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Agreement, the Contractor shall notify all customers about service inquiry procedures, regulations and day(s) of collection. On collection day, if the waste to be collected by Contractor is improperly mixed with wastes that Contractor is not to collect, as set forth in Section 5 of this Addendum, or if the Approved Containers are inaccessible or improperly placed or overloaded, then the Contractor shall not be obligated to collect such waste and shall notify the Customer and the County Solid Waste Director within 24 hours of the reasons for the non-Service.
- 10. County and Contractor understand and agree that the rates set forth in the Agreement are based on an initial count of 17,893 Roll Out Carts. If at any time during the term of Agreement, as amended by this Addendum, the number of Roll Out Carts placed with customers increases and/or decreases more than 10% or more from the original totals stated above, the parties shall meet within ten (10) days for good faith negotiations on a rate adjustment to account for the Contractor's adjusted cost per Customer; and if the parties cannot agree on a new rate within ten (10) days of the first meeting, then the Contractor or County may terminate this Contract immediately upon written notice without liability for such termination.
- 11. In the event that the County does not agree on the number of Customers that have been Serviced in a given month after receipt of an invoice for that month, the County may (1) accept the number of Customers on the Contractor's invoice for the relevant month and/or (2) make a written request that a joint count be conducted in the following month, the results of which shall be used to determine the invoice amount. The number reached in the joint count will be used going forward. If the County does not make a written request for a joint count within fifteen (15) days of receiving the invoice, and/or if the County does not cooperate in performing a joint count that is convenient for both parties, the County will have waived this right for the then-current month and must pay the invoiced amount.
- 12. In the event that Section 14.1 or 14.2 of the Agreement is triggered, both parties agree to follow the following procedures:

Upon obtaining knowledge of any demand, matter or claim (a "Third Party Claim") giving rise to possible indemnification, the party (the "Notifying Party") that believes it is entitled to indemnification shall notify the other party (the "Indemnifying Party") immediately in writing, and in reasonable detail of such Third Party Claim (the "Indemnifying Party"), as promptly as reasonably possible after receipt by the Notifying Party of written notice of the Third Party Claim; provided however, that failure to give such notification will not affect the indemnification provided under this Agreement except to the extent the Indemnifying Party has been actually prejudiced as a result of the failure to provide prompt and reasonably detailed written notice. Thereafter, the Notifying Party shall deliver to the Indemnifying party, within five business days after the Notifying Party's receipt of notice, copies of all notices and documents (including court papers) received by the Notifying Party relating to the Third Party Claim. The Indemnifying Party shall have the right to defend or contest any such claim or demand in the name of the Notifying Party at the option of Columbus County. The Notifying Party shall provide such cooperation in connection therewith as the Indemnifying Party may reasonably request and shall make available to the Indemnifying Party or its representatives all records and other materials reasonably required in such defense and which is not privileged by law.

If a Third Party Claim is made against an Notifying Party, the Indemnifying Party will be entitled to participate in the defense of such claim, and, if it so chooses and acknowledges its obligations to indemnify the Notifying Party therefore, to or will assume the defense of such claim with counsel selected by the Indemnifying Party and reasonably satisfactory to the Notifying Party. Notwithstanding any acknowledgment made pursuant to the immediately proceeding sentence, the Indemnifying Party shall be entitled to continue to assert any limitation on its indemnification responsibility based on the provisions of the Agreement. Should the Indemnifying Party so elect to assume the defense of a Third Party Claim, the Indemnifying Party will not be liable to the Notifying Party for legal expenses subsequently incurred by the Notifying Party in connection with the defense thereof. If the Indemnifying Party assumes such defense, the Notifying Party shall have the right to participate in the defense thereof and to employ counsel, at its own expense, separate from the counsel employed by the Indemnifying Party, with the understanding that the Indemnifying Party shall control the defense thereof. The Indemnifying Party shall be liable for the reasonable fees and expenses of counsel employed by the Notifying Party for any period during which the Indemnifying Party has not assumed defense thereof. If the Indemnifying Party chooses to defend a Third Party Claim, the parties shall cooperate in the defense or prosecution of the claim. This cooperation will include the retention and (upon the Indemnifying Party's request) the provision to the Indemnifying Party of records and information that are reasonably relevant to such Third Party Claim, and making employees, agents, officers and/or contractors available on a mutually convenient basis to provide additional information and explanation of any material provided hereunder. Whether or not the Indemnifying Party assumes defense of the Third Party Claim, the Notifying Party shall not admit any liability with respect to, or settle, compromise, or discharge, such Third Party Claim without the Indemnifying Party's prior written consent (which consent will not be unreasonably withheld). If the Indemnifying Party shall have assumed the defense of the Third Party Claim, the Indemnifying Party shall not settle such Third Party Claim without the Notifying Party's prior written consent (which consent will not be unreasonably withheld).

So long as the Indemnifying Party Indemnifying Party is contesting or defending any such claim or demand in good faith, no amount shall be deemed to be due hereunder unless Notifying Party has been required by order of any regulatory agency or court order to pay any sum or comply with some order of court arising from the subject matter of the suit, legal fees not withstanding..

13. Notice under the Agreement, as amended by this Addendum shall be deemed delivered when deposited in the United States mail, registered or certified mail, return receipt requested, and addressed to the parties at the addresses listed below. Also, the addresses designated below may be changed from time to time by written notice in accordance with this paragraph.

The Agreement and this Addendum constitute the entire agreement and understanding between the parties with respect to the subject matter, and it shall not be considered modified, altered, changed or amended in any respect unless in writing and signed by the parties hereto. Except as expressly set forth in this Addendum, all other terms and provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

15. In the event a breach of the Agreement, as amended by this Addendum by either party, the breaching party shall pay all reasonable attorneys' fees, collection fees and costs of the other party incident to any action brought to enforce the Agreement, as amended by this Addendum.

Agenda Item #8: RESOLUTION - RESOLUTION REQUESTING INSTALLATION of TRAFFIC SAFETY DEVICES at S.R. 1429 OLD PINE LOG ROAD and S.R. 1005 PEACOCK ROAD:

Commissioner Godwin requested Board approval and adoption of the following Resolution due to the many traffic fatalities that have occurred recently.

RESOLUTION REQUESTING INSTALLATION of TRAFFIC SAFETY DEVICES

at S.R. 1429 Old Pine Log Road and S.R. 1005 Peacock Road

WHEREAS, there exists an intersection within Columbus County at State Road 1429, Old Pine Log Road, and State Road 1005, Peacock Road, which has claimed the lives of several people over the last few years and has proven to be detrimental to those who travel the same; and

WHEREAS, the said intersection is considered to be highly dangerous due to poor signage, and a source of fatality for drivers who utilize it; and

WHEREAS, historically, this intersection is heavily traveled by the citizens of Columbus County and by travelers outside of Columbus County; and

WHEREAS, several lives have been claimed at this particular intersection; and

WHEREAS, there exists a great need for the installation of traffic safety devices (i.e., flashing caution light, sign reading stop sign ahead, look right sign, rumble strips) at this particular intersection to avoid these accidents from happening that rob people of their lives and inflict devastating injury to those who do survive thereby robbing them of a full life; and

WHEREAS, we, as the Board of Commissioners for the County of Columbus, do whatever is necessary, within the realms of our duties, to provide the best safety for our citizens and provide good and sound protection for them; and

WHEREAS, the need for the installation of safety traffic devices has existed for a long period of time, plus the additional utilization of this said intersection, has heightened this need to be executed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Columbus County Board of Commissioners requests the North Carolina Department of Transportation to install some type of traffic safety device (whatever is deemed appropriate) at the intersection of State Road 1429, Old Pine Log Road, and State Road 1005, Peacock Road.

Agenda Item #10: <u>APPOINTMENTS - CRIMINAL JUSTICE PARTNERSHIP</u> <u>ADVISORY BOARD</u>:

Kay Horne, Chair of the Columbus County Criminal Justice Partnership Advisory Board, requested the following two (2) appointments and one (1) reappointment.

Appointments: 1) Dawn Mehalic, TASC, 102 Memory Plaza, Whiteville, North Carolina 28472 (Term Position; and

2) Ricky Rouse, Treatment Provider, P.O. Box 732, Whiteville, North Carolina 28472 (Term Position).

Reappointment: Rachel Brown, ESC Job Service, Employment and Training, Term: 3 years (7/04 to 6/07).

Commissioner Wilson made a motion to approve the two (2) appointments and the one (1) reappointment, as listed above, to the Columbus County Criminal Justice Partnership Advisory Board, seconded by Commissioner McKenzie. The motion so carried.

Agenda Item #11: AIRPORT - DEPARTMENTAL UPDATE:

Phil Edwards, Secretary of the Columbus County Airport Authority, presented the following Departmental Update on the Columbus County Airport activities:

- 1. The Columbus County Airport is a very important part of the infrastructure of Columbus County;
- 2. We are presently in the process of upgrading the Airport;
- 3. I have discovered there is plenty of grant money out there for airports, but Columbus County has not been requesting their share of these funds;
- 4. We have received multiple grants starting in the year of 2001 and we are applying these grants to the upgrade of the airport;
- 5. In one (1) grant, we received funds in the amount of one hundred fifty thousand and 00/100 (\$150,000.00) dollars, and will be receiving the same amount for the years 2005 through 2007;
- 6. We have requested funds totaling over \$3 million;
- 7. We are in the process if hiring a consultant firm;

- 8. We have been promised a localizer
- 9. The Columbus County Airport has been named for money needed in Congress for AIP funds.

Commissioner Godwin asked Mr. Edwards if he had done any adjustments in the fuel charges. Mr. Edwards replied stating that the Airport was right where they needed to be on the fuel charges. Our fuel prices are an enticement to attract pilots of various levels which could lead to some economic development. The North Carolina Department of Aviation is pleased with our fuel pricing. We are making a small profit and our Airport is open every day of the year except Christmas Day and this provides an outlet not available at other places.

Commissioner McKenzie asked Mr. Edwards if there was anything at the Airport to recognize President Clinton's visit to Columbus County. Mr. Edwards replied stating yes.

Chairman Memory asked Mr. Edwards who does the moving at the Airport. Mr. Edwards replied stating that he does a portion, Parks and Recreation does a portion and Ray Canady does the wetlands.

Agenda Item #12: CONSENT AGENDA ITEMS:
