PUBLIC HEARING - Secondary Road Construction Program: the purpose of this Public hearing is to receive input from citizens regarding expenditures of secondary construction funds for improvement of secondary roads in Columbus County.

PUBLIC HEARING CALLED to ORDER:

At 6:30 P.M., Chairman Jacobs called the Public Hearing to order, and stated the purpose of this Public Hearing is to receive input from citizens regarding expenditures of secondary construction funds for improvement of secondary roads in Columbus County.

H.L."Drew" Cox, PE, District Engineer with North Carolina Department of Transportation, stated that as per the list I have provided to you, the FY 2007-2008 Secondary Road Improvement Program will include the following:

- 1. Under the Paving Unpaved Roads, we have eight (8) roads listed for a total of \$1,832,941.28;
- 2. Under the Paved Road Improvements, we have listed three (3) roads for a total of \$890.000.00:
- 3. Under Maintenance Operations, there is a total of \$469,514.68 which will be used for activities such as: shoulder repair; spot stabilization, pipe replacement, safety projects, industrial access, etc:
- 4. Under Reserve for Contingencies, there is a total of \$194,110.84 which will be used for surveying, right-of-way acquisition, continuation down the priority paving list, road additions, contingencies, overdrafts, and paving entrances to certified fire departments, rescue squads, etc.; and
- 5. The 2007-2008 Program Summary is 5.09 Miles at the cost of \$3,386,566.80, and involves forty-four (44) homes and no businesses.

Chairman Jacobs stated that one (1) Public Comment Card had been received from Robert Adams. Mr. Adams stated the following:

- 1. Red Store Road is in bad condition:
- 2. There is a small section of this road that is paved;
- 3. There is a lot of tile on this road that is caving in;
- 4. At places, the road is beat all to pieces;
- 5. At one location on this road, at the County line near Highway 701 and Charlie Lennon Road, there exists several branch areas that is very low, and school buses are getting bogged down and having to be pulled out, and there is a great need for tile to be installed in these areas; and
- 6. This road needs some serious attention.

Mac Campbell, North Carolina Board of Transportation Board Member for Division 6, introduced Ken Murphy, Division Maintenance Engineer for Division 6, and Ken Clark, Columbus County Maintenance Engineer, and stated the following:

- 1. Mr. Cox has covered this program quite well;
- 2. We appreciate your understanding of this process; and
- 3. There are always more requests that we have funds to do.

Commissioner McKenzie stated the following:

- 1. Mr. Cox you have done a remarkable job;
- 2. You respond to the telephone calls you receive which is greatly appreciated;
- 3. You have a working crew with a good attitude; and
- 4. You do good work.

Commissioner Memory asked Mr. Cox what the status of the Highway 701 Business and Highway 701 Bypass merge was. Mr. Cox replied stating the following:

- 1. In accordance with the present plans, there will be a letting in June 2008;
- 2. At the present time, this project is in the right-of-way stage;
- 3. This is a North Carolina State Move-Ahead Project;
- 4. It will take sixteen to eighteen (16-18) months before completion;
- 5. This is a design engineering project; and
- 6. If everything goes well, this project will go out for bid in September 2008.

PUBLIC HEARING CLOSED:

Phil Edwards, Airport Manager, requested Board approval to purchase the Richard Palmer Johnson Parcel of land for the Columbus County Airport Runway 6-24, at the cost of eighty thousand and 00/100 (\$80,000.00) dollars, and containing 12.12 acres of land. Mr. Edwards stated the following:

- 1. John Massey, Consulting Engineer with Talbert and Bright, is here tonight to answer any questions you may have;
- 2. All the necessary leg work and paper work has been done for this acquisition; and
- 3. This will be advantageous to the Columbus County Airport.

Commissioner Memory made a motion to approve the purchase of the Richard Palmer Johnson Parcel for the Columbus County Airport Runway 6-24, at the cost of eighty thousand and 00/100 (\$80,000.00) dollars, and containing 12.12 acres of land, seconded by Commissioner McKenzie. The motion unanimously carried. This document will be marked as Exhibit "A" and filed in the Minute Book Attachments, Book Number 2, in the Clerk to the Board's Office for review.

Agenda Item #7: ADMINISTRATION - 2007 SINGLE FAMILY REHABILITATION (SFR) PROGRAM, APPROVAL of PROCUREMENT and DISBURSEMENT POLICY, and ASSISTANCE POLICY:

Jim Varner, County Manager, requested Board approval of the following documents for the 2007 Single Family Rehabilitation (SFR) Program:

- 1. Procurement Policy / Disbursement Policy; and
- 2. Assistance Policy.

Mr. Varner stated the following:

- 1. Columbus County was awarded a \$400,000.00 grant from the North Carolina Housing Finance Agency to rehabilitate approximately eight (8) houses;
- 2. These documents are requirements of the funding agency in order to move forward with the application process;
- 3. The Procurement Policy outlines bid procedures;
- 4. The Disbursement policy outlines guidelines for disbursement of funds to contractors;
- 5. The Assistance Policy describes the program and its objectives, eligibility requirements of such program, marketing of the program, terms of assistance and the application process, and has been reviewed and approved by the North Carolina Housing Finance Agency.

Commissioner Memory made a motion to approve the Procurement Policy / Disbursement Policy and the Assistance Policy for the 2007 Single Family Rehabilitation Program, seconded by Commissioner McKenzie. The motion unanimously carried. These two (2) documents will be marked as Exhibit "B" and Exhibit "C" and filed in the Minute Book Attachments, Book Number 2, for review.

Agenda Item #8: GOVERNMENT COMPLEX ROAD - APPROVAL of AGREEMENT for SERVICES:

Stuart Carroll, Purchasing Director, requested Board approval of a Proposal for Jurisdictional Delineation, and an Agreement for Services (Form AS-071) for the Columbus County Government Complex - Government Complex Road. Mr. Carroll stated the following:

- 1. At the September 4, 2007 Board Meeting, Paul Masten, Engineering Consultant with S&ME, delivered an update on the status of Government Complex Road;
- 2. It was stated by Paul that only one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the site had been reviewed at the cost of one thousand, four hundred, and 00/100 (\$1,400.00) dollars;
- 3. Due to the environmental concerns that had been expressed by the Army Corps of Engineers and the possibility of the impact of future development, the Board requested that Paul present a proposal for the cost of reviewing the remainder of the site; **and**
- 4. This is the proposal he is presenting and the Agreement for Services at the cost of one thousand, four hundred, and 00/100 (\$1,400.00) dollars.

Steven W. Fowler, County Attorney, stated this Agreement did not include a required Pre-Audit Statement which would serve as a verification by the Finance Officer that the funds are available for the costs entailed. Leo Hunt, Interim Finance Officer, stated the funds could be transferred for this cost.

Vice Chairman Prevatte made a motion to approve the Proposal for Jurisdictional Delineation, and the Agreement for Services (Form AS-071), for the Columbus County Government Complex - Government Complex Road, at the cost of one thousand, four hundred, and 00/100 (\$1,400.00) dollars, seconded by Commissioner Norris. The motion unanimously carried.

Commissioner Memory stated the proposal and agreement were not inclusive of all the costs entailed for this project, and the Board would need to know what the entire cost would be, and then determine if the funds were available for such.

Mr. Carroll stated he had been talking with Greg Burns, North Carolina Department of Transportation, and there may be a possibility of the Department of Transportation sharing the cost for this to be done.

Vice Chairman Prevatte withdrew his motion and Commissioner Norris withdrew his second.

Vice Chairman Prevatte made a motion to table the Agreement for Services with S&ME for Government Complex Road until a total cost was determined, and the funds are located for the said cost, seconded by Commissioner Norris. The motion unanimously carried.

Agenda Item #9: <u>DISCUSSION - EMS MEDICAL DIRECTOR'S CONTRACT</u>:

Chairman Sammie Jacobs requested Board discussion of the EMS Medical Director's contract.

Commissioner Memory made a motion to table the discussion of the EMS Medical Director's Contract, and for Steven W. Fowler, County Attorney, to send a letter to Columbus Regional

Healthcare System notifying them of a sixty (60) day notice of the termination of the Nurse Liaison position, seconded by Vice Chairman Prevatte.

Morris Pridgen, Library Director, delivered the following Departmental Update to the Board.

- 1. Our Mission Statement is to provide modern library resources and services necessary to satisfy the evolving informational needs and recreational pursuits of the citizens;
- 2. Public library services began in Columbus County in 1921 when the City of Whiteville formed the Whiteville Library Association;
- 3. Columbus County Library developed from bookmobile service which began in 1946;
- 4. Due to the LSTA Grant and the Gates Grants, we have replaced most of our public computers throughout the system;
- 5. The Gates Grant also helped provide the Smart Access Management System (SAMS) computer program, which provides computer time management for patrons and print management;
- 6. We are a full-service library and provide library services through the headquarters in Whiteville and five (5) branch libraries as follows:
 - -Chadbourn Community Library
 - -Fair Bluff Community Library
 - -Rube McCray Memorial Library;
 - -East Columbus Branch Library; and
 - -Tabor City Public Library;
- 7. Our services include the following:
 - -Adult and Children's Reference Services;
 - -Magazines, Newspapers, Videos, Audio Cassettes;
 - -Children's Story Time;
 - -Summer Reading Program;
 - -Word Processors:
 - -Public Access Internet;
 - -Access to Typewriters;
 - -Inter-Library Loan;
 - -Homebound Service;
 - -Bookmobile
 - -Local History;
 - -Genealogy; and
 - -Copier / Fax Services;
- 8. Columbus County Public Libraries' Annual Statistics:

-Circulation Grant Total 205,958
-Total Computer Users 38,065
-Total Reference questions 29,747
-Total Door County 99,509
-Outreach Services 908; and

- 9. The notable groups and events are as follows:
 - -Fair Bluff Library Board sponsored the Watermelon Festival Dinner to raise money for the Library;
 - -Tabor City Library Board purchased four (4) computers to be placed into the library;
 - -Tabor City has a new Friends Group to contribute to the library;
 - -Chadbourn Library Board sponsored a hot dog sale and chicken bog to raise money;
 - -Carolyn T. High Library contributes by having book sales;
 - -Lake Waccamaw Library Board and the neighboring community raise monies by having a fish fry at McNeil's Lake House weekly; **and**
 - -Riegelwood Library is now finishing a remodeling project.

BICENTENNIAL COMMITTEE - APPOINTMENT CHANGES:

Commissioner Bill Memory stated he was removing Mary Alice Stanley from the Columbus County Bicentennial Committee, and appointing Rob Cross, who is presently serving as an exofficio member, to fill this position as a voting member.

AGENDA ADD-ON:

Item #1: <u>ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT - UPDATE on STATUS of ONGOING PROJECTS:</u>

Jim Hinkle, Interim Economic Development Director, delivered the following update on the status of ongoing projects:

- 1. The Chaos Boat Company has moved into one of the Fin Chem buildings in the Delco area. They plan to make boats and employ seventeen to twenty (17-20) people. They also are planning to make boats for another company next year, which would greatly increase their employees.;
- 2. We have a good prospect for the Interkordsa building which will employ sixty (60) people.;
- 3. We are working on a prospect for the Conflandey Building which is a large boat manufacturing project and encountered a stall on this project last week.;
- 4. We are working with two (2) prospects for the Shell Building. One is a German firm and will manufacture chemicals for a smooth finish to metals. The other one is a North Carolina firm that manufactures a marine product.;
- 5. I am working with a power project who will utilize waste timber to generate electricity within an one hundred (100) mile radius of their plant. They are looking at a site near Fair Bluff and are impressed with it. It is close to a Progress Energy transmission line and substation. The company plans to build a facility first on the Duke System and then build one for Progress Energy on the Fair Bluff site if it is still available next year.;
- 6. We are working on a large project that:
 - -needed a barge site, I located one in eastern Columbus County;
 - -will employ one thousand (1,000) people;
 - -North Carolina has submitted two (2) sites;
 - -this particular project requested sites from ten (10) states;
 - -working with Four County and Wilmington Committee of 100 on this project, the company has eliminated the other site in North Carolina, but I do not know how many sites the company is looking at in the other states;
- 7. We are working with Brunswick County and the Ports Authority on a 1,000 acre distribution park. About 200 acres of the park would be in Columbus County, which would have the benefits of a Tier 1 County for the purpose of State incentives. Brunswick County has offered to furnish water and sewage facilities to the site.;
- 8. Top Tobacco is proceeding with its expansion which will employ seventy (70) people and be a \$16.8 million investment.
