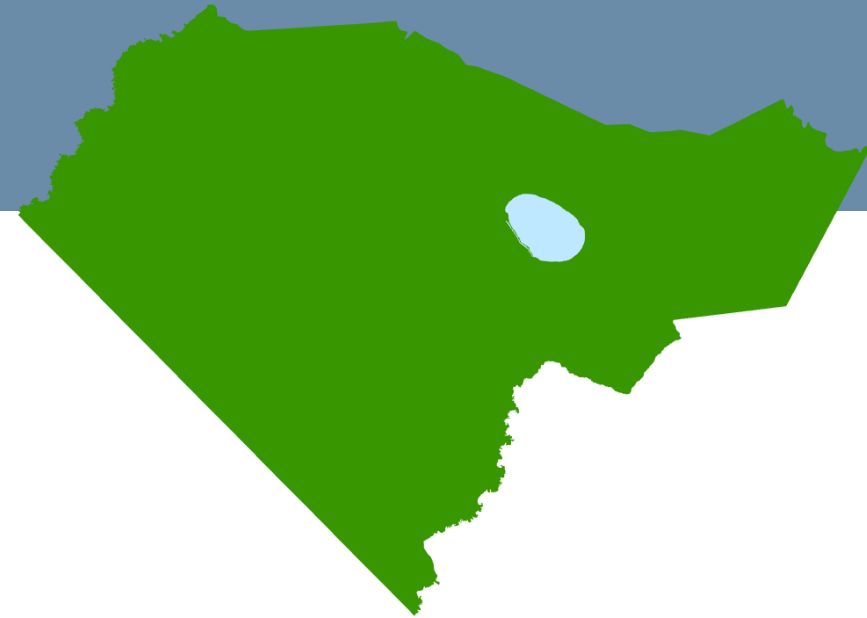


# COLUMBUS COUNTY

## Comprehensive Transportation Plan

The Transportation Planning Division of the North Carolina Department of Transportation, in cooperation with Columbus County, and the Cape Fear Rural Transportation Planning Organization, is developing a Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP) that identifies the long-range transportation needs for Columbus County over the next thirty years. The CTP is a plan that includes roadways, rail, public transportation, bicycle, and pedestrian improvements, and the public's input is vital in developing a plan that meets the future needs of the citizens of Columbus County.

The public is invited to the following drop-in workshops where there will be an opportunity to view and comment on maps of recommended future transportation improvements and ask questions about the CTP. All workshops will present the same maps and information.
