Whereas, certain citizens and taxpayers of Columbus County have petitioned the Board to request the State Highway Commission to build a new road leading from the Whiteville and Tabor highway # 23 near the Henry Tyre estate in a westerly direction a distance of about two miles and intersecting the Clarendon road near the W. A. Bass estate and leads directly west into the Peacock road.

Now, therefore, Be it Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County, that the State Highway Commission be requested to take over the said road above described and a copy of this resolution be sent to the State Highway Commission and a copy recorded on the minutes of this board.

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners has been requested to petition the State Highway Commission to take from the State road map a certain private road which leads from highway No. 23 and runs through the Sandy Nance farm to the Abbottsburch-Clarkton road a distance of about one and one-fourth mile, and which road has never been maintained by the county or township, but by one certain family and serves the public in no way.

Now, therefore, Be it Resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County, that the State Highway Commission be requested to take the said road from the system now maintained by the State, and that a copy of this resolution be sent to the State Highway Commission and a copy recorded on the minutes of this Board.
