Ordered: That Officers for Court and Grand Jury be paid \$2.00 per day and mileage as per regular Jurors.

Whereas, certain citizens of Columbus County have petitioned the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County to request the State Highway Commission to take over and maintain a certain stretch of public road in Cerro Gordo Line Railroad at Frink's Crossing, extending to Nance's Crossing; thence to Route # 202, a distance of about one and a half miles; and

Whereas, the said citizens set out the fact that this road has been maintained by the Township Road Commission:

Now, therefore, Be It Resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County that the State Highway Commission be requested to take over and maintain the said road in Cerro Gordo Township; and

Be It Further Resolved that a copy of this resolution, together with the petition, be forwarded to the North Carolina State Highway Commission at Raleigh and a copy placed upon the minutes of this Board.

Whereas, certain citizens of Columbus County have petitioned the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County to request the State Highway Commission to place upon the State Highway map a certain piece or link of road, the same being located in Crusoe Island: Beginning at Fish Pon Road near the old Baptist Church site, and runs about East to Southeast to the Old Dock and Juniper Creek Road near J. I. Simmons' place, one and three quarters miles; and

Whereas, the said citizens set out the fact that this road has recently been rebuilt with Federal Relief Funds; and

Whereas, the said road has a width of twenty two (22) feet in the clear, graded, drained and levelled:

Now, therefore, Be It Resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County that the State Highway Commission be requested to take over and place on the said State Highway map the said road located in Crusoe Island; and

Be It further Resolved: that a copy of this resolution together with the petition, be forwarded to the North Carolina State Highway Commission at Raleigh, and a copy placed upon the minutes of this Board.

Whereas, certain citizens of Columbus County have petitioned the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County to request the State Highway Commission to place upon the State Highway map a road leading from Hinson and Blackman Road near O'Berry Stephens' place, to Slab Bay Road, at or near E. D. Tyres, a distance of about one and one half ($1\frac{1}{2}$) miles; and

Whereas, the said road is a much travelled road:

Now, therefore, Be It Resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County that the State Highway Commission be requested to take over and maintain the said road above referred to; and

Be It Further Resolved that a copy of this resolution together with the petition, be forwarded to the North Carolina State Highway Commission at Raleigh and a copy placed upon the minutes of this Board.
