Ordered: that the County provide Countys' part of required salary and travel to pay a George Reed Home Economic teacher for the Tabor High School.

Ordered: that J. H. Baldwin Est. in Bogue Township be separated so Luther Shipman may pay taxes on 17 acres which he has mortgage on.

Ordered: that Mrs. Emma K. Santa be refunded tax for 1934 on \$285.00 and Her valuation be reduced from \$935. to \$650. on account of valuation being increased on house.

Ordered: that no vouchers be delivered to A. S. and Francis B. Richardson until their house rent is paid.

Ordered: that C. E. Williamson 75 acres tract of land in Chadbourn Township be separated so taxes now due may be paid on said tract of land.

Ordered: that Margaret B. Moyers be allowed to pay her note and mortgage to Columbus County for \$1,450.00 cash and the Chairman is authorized and instructed to cancel said mortgage of record when said amount is paid.

Ordered: that order passed allowing Mrs. Barnhardt to take down fence at old Jail be rescinded and that the fence be allowed to remain for garden for Jailor.

Ordered: that whereas, the term of office of D. L. Gore, Tax Collector of Columbus County expires December 1st, 1934, it is therefore ordered that R. J. Lamb be and he is hereby appointed Tax Collector of Columbus County to collect taxes of said County for the year 1934-1935 as required by Law at a salary of \$1,500.00.

Ordered: that J. L. Ripple Estate be allowed to pay 1930 taxes in Whiteville Township by paying 6% interest flat and Court Cost, instead of regular penalty.

Whereas, said road which it is desired by said citizens that the State Highway Commission take over and maintain is a road beginning at the Brick Yard about one mile north of the Court House on Route #23 and runs East through the Richardson, Spivey, and Baldwin farms, and intersects Route #20 about one mile East of the Court House, a distance of about one and two-tenths miles; and,

Whereas, this road is now being used as a Rural Mail Route and serves several families getting to and from Route #20 and #23, and is almost impassible:
