Be it ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that one note of the county of Columbus for General School purposes be executed in the sum of Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.00) Dollars, dated March 1st 1940, maturing July 15th 1940.

The above note bearing interest at the rate of $1\frac{1}{2}\%$ per annum, interest payable at maturity; both principal and interest of said note payable to BEARER at Wachovia Bank and Trust Company, Winston Salem, N. C. in anticipation of 1939 taxes, and that said note be sold or hypothecated and the proceeds there-of turned into the General Fund of said County of Columbus.
