

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office Monday, August 3, 1942, it being first Monday. Members of the Board present:

The following business was transacted.

Ordered: that Mrs. Lee Walker be allowed to pay Eunice, Ruth and Leonard Duncan, Bogue Township taxes for years 1933, 1934, 1935, 1936, 1937 and 1938 on 1941 valuation at par plus 6% and 1/2 court cost.

Ordered: that 74 acres tract of land valued \$1130 be segregated from lands listed by Ellis Strickland, Cerro Gordo Township, for the year 1941 and that same be charged to Howard Strickland who has bought said 74 acres, and that the tax collector be refunded on \$700 valuation listed in error on 69 acres tract for same year.

Ordered: that real property tax listed by L. E. Tyner, Tatum Township, be segregated so that he can pay personal tax and T. A. Tyner can pay on the real property, he having bought same.

Ordered: that Leo L. Fisher, Register of Deeds, be allowed to record map of Sunny South Colony, Chadbourn N. C., without charge.

Ordered: that lot valued at \$300 and listed to F. M. Smith on penalty list for year 1941 be cancelled, same being a double-listing.

Ordered: that Mary Floyd be allowed to settle Dr. J. W. Floyd Estate taxes, South Williams Township, for years 1935, 1936, 1937 and 1938 at 6% flat and 1/2 court cost.

Ordered: that A. L. Brown property, Ransom Township, owned by Columbus County under tax foreclosure proceedings, be sold to A. L. Brown for \$146.84 and deed be executed to him by the Chairman and Clerk.

Ordered: that one lot valued at \$1100 and one lot valued at \$150 and listed by Len Tyler, South Williams Township, for year 1942, be corrected to read " one lot valued at \$500 and one lot valued at \$300; it is further ordered that the tax collector be refunded on \$450 valuation, the difference caused by error.

Ordered: that tax collector be refunded on \$550 valuation on E. M. Eutsler's 1942 tax due to error in listing.

Ordered: that 10 acres valued at \$260 be segregated from 33 acres tract valued at \$1365 and listed by W. H. Armstrong, Welches Creek Township, so that W. C. Armstrong who has heired same, can pay taxes thereon for year 1941.

Ordered: that Chairman and Clerk be authorized and instructed to sign Bond Interest and Redemption Fund voucher in the amount of \$2,875.43 to pay principal, interest and exchange due September 1st on County Hospital bonds dated 3/1/39.

Ordered: that an additional \$100 be allowed on the cost of boiler for Nurses' Home.

Ordered: that J. L. Carr, Bolton, N. C., be issued General County voucher for \$2.00 to refund Poll and penalty listed for year 1941 when he was a non-resident.

RESOLUTION

No. 1

Ordered: that the following resolution be recorded relative to borrowing Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.00) Dollars for General School purposes, same being renewal note.

Be it ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that one note of the County of Columbus for General School purposes be executed in the sum of Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.00) Dollars dated August 14, 1942, maturing December 14, 1942.

The above note bearing interest at the rate of two and one-half (2½%) percent per annum, interest payable at maturity; both principal and interest of said note payable to BEARER at FIRST CITIZENS BANK AND TRUST COMPANY, RALEIGH, NORTH CAROLINA, in anticipation of 1942 and prior years taxes, and that said note be sold or hypothecated and the proceeds thereof turned into the General Fund of said County of Columbus.

Be it further resolved that the full faith and credit of the County of Columbus be pledged to the punctual payment of the principal and interest of said note at maturity.

REVENUE ANTICIPATION NOTE

The County of Columbus, in the State of North Carolina, hereby acknowledges itself indebted and for value received promises to pay to the bearer in lawful money of the United States of America the sum of Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.00) Dollars on the 14th day of December 1942, with interest thereon from date at the rate of

2 1/2 percent per annum. Both principal of and interest on this note are payable at FIRST CITIZENS BANK AND TRUST COMPANY, RALEIGH, NORTH CAROLINA.

This note is issued pursuant to the County Finance Act, as amended, and a resolution duly adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of said County for necessary expenses and for the purpose of paying the principal or interest of bonds or notes due or to become due within four months and not otherwise adequately provided for, and in anticipation of the receipt of taxes and other revenue of the current fiscal year.

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED AND RECITED, that all acts, conditions and things required by the statutes and Constitution of the State of North Carolina to be performed, happen and exist precedent to and in the issuance of this note have been performed, have happened and exist, and that this note is within every debt and other limitation prescribed by said statutes and Constitution. For the prompt payment hereof, both principal and interest as the same fall due, the full faith and credit of said County are hereby irrevocably pledged.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the said County of Columbus has caused this note to be signed by the Chairman of its Board of County Commissioners and by the Clerk of said Board and its corporate seal to be impressed hereon, all as of the 14th day of August, 1942.
