REVENUE ANTICIPATION

NOTE

The County of Columbus, in the State of North Carolina, hereby acknowledges itself indebted and for value received promises to pay to the bearer in lawful money of the United States of America the sum of Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.00) Dollars on the 14th day of July, 1943, with interest thereon from date at the rate of 1 3/4 % percent per annum. Both principal and interest on this note are payable at First Citizens Bank and Trust Company, Raleigh, North Carolina.

This note is issued pursuant to the County Finance Act, as amended, and a resolution duly adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of said County for necessary expenses and for the purpose of paying the principal or interest of bonds or notes due or to become due within four months and not otherwise adequately provided for, and in anticipation of the receipt of taxes and other revenues of the current fiscal year.

It is hereby certified and recited that all acts, conditions and things required by the statutes and Constitution of the State of North Carolina to be performed, happen and exist precedent to the and in the issuance of this note have been performed, have happened and exist, and that this note is within every debt and other limitation prescribed by said statutes and Constitution. For the prompt payment hereof, both principal and interest as the same fall due, the full faith and credit of said County are hereby irrevocably pledged.

In witness whereof, the said County of Columbus has caused this note to be signed by the Chairman of its Board of County Commissioners and by the Clerk of said Board and its corporate seal to be impressed hereon, all as of the 14th day of April, 1943.

RESOLUTION

No. 1

Ordered: that the following resolution be recorded relative to borrowing Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.00) Dollars for General School purposes, same being renewal note.

Be it ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County that one note of the County of Columbus for General Schools purposes be executed in the sum of Fifteen/<sup>Thousand</sup>(\$15,000.00) Dollars dated April 14, 1943, maturing July 14, 1943.

The above note bearing interest at the rate of one and three-fourths (1 3/4%) per cent per annum, interest payable at maturity; both principal and interest of said note payable to BEARER at First Citizens Bank and Trust Company, Raleigh, N. C. in anticipation of 1942 taxes, and that said note be sold or hypothecated and the proceeds thereof turned into the General Fund of said County of Columbus.

Be it further resolved that the full faith and credit of the County of Columbus be pledged to the punctual payment of the principal and interest of said note at maturity.

Ordered: that one \$500 Town of Rose Hill Water and Sewer 6% bond No. 2 due 4-1-43, placed with Wachovia Bank and Trust Company, Raleigh, N. C. by Waccamaw Bank and Trust Company, Whiteville, N. C. for security of deposits of Columbus County and held subject to the order of the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County, be released.

Ordered: that 1935 tax listed by Helen Edwards, South Williams Township, be cancelled as same property was listed and paid by L. R. Fowler for said year.

Ordered: that taxes of Mortie Barnhill, Tatum Township, for year 1927 be segregated so that W. H. Harrelson can pay tax on 15 acres of Benton land valued at \$600, and F. M. Barnhill can pay the tax on 1 lot valued at \$400.

Ordered: that upon payment of tax deed of A. K. Collins by him, that \$50.00 be deducted from the total provided same is paid within 60 days from date.

Ordered: that Jasper Bowen be allowed to pay D. J. Bowen, Whiteville Township, 1928 tax at 6% flat and 1/2 court cost.

Ordered: that John Wright, Tabor City, N. C., be given \$3.00 relief check monthly until further ordered.

Ordered: that C. H. Hinson, Chadbourn Township taxes for 1937 and prior years be cancelled and originals delivered to Mr. Elroy Bailey in accordance with order passed January 12th, 1938.

Ordered: that Julia Henderson property in Whiteville Township, county owned through tax foreclosure, be sold to Jimmie Jones and wife, Sadie Jones, for \$75.36 and deed be executed therefor.

Ordered: that Silas Dubar property in Ransom Township, county owned through tax foreclosure, be sold to Silas Dubar and wife, Bedie Dubar, Armour, N. C. for \$55.26 and deed be executed therefor.

Ordered: that Morgan Soles property, South Williams Township, county owned through tax foreclosure, be sold to Morgan Soles for \$57.23 and that upon payment of said amount, deed be executed therefor.
