Ordered: That Veneda S. Ray be employed as County Accountant and Clerk to the Board of Commissioners, effective February 15, 1961 at a salary rate of \$300.00 per month.

Ordered: That the salary of Lolly G. Johnson be raised to \$300.00 per month, effective January 1, 1961.

Ordered: That the following resolution be passed:

After discussion of the present jury fees of the County, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

"BE IT RESOLVED: That the Honorable, Arthur W. Williamson, Columbus County Representative, be requested to sponsor necessary legislation to repeal special action of the 1947 General Assembly wherein the jury fees of Columbus County were fixed at \$5.00 per day, and enact necessary legislation for Columbus County to come under the general law, North Carolina General Statute 9-5 entitled "Fees of Jurors", wherein the County Board of Commissioners has the right to fix compensation for jurors in their respective counties not less than \$3.00 per day and not more than \$8.00 per day."
