Upon motion duly made and seconded and unanimously passed, the following resolution was adopted;

The Chairman of the Columbus County Board of Commissioners is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners FHA Form 400-4, "Non Discrimination Agreement", and FHA Form 400-1, "Equal Opportunity Agreement", and all other necessary forms or revisions thereof in order to comply with the requirements of FHA in connection with the grant for water and sewer studies in Columbus County.

Upon motion made by Comm. Watts, seconded by Comm. Gore and unanimously carried, it was ordered that this Board recommend to the county legislative delegation that the fees authorized to be collected by constables in Columbus County be increased to the same as are now authorized to be collected by constables in counties adjoining Columbus.

Ordered: that the North Carolina Department of Archives and History be authorized to conduct an inventory of the public records in various offices in Columbus County, and repair as necessary, and microfilm for security those records classified as permanently valuable. The North Carolina Department of Archives and History is further authorized to temporarily remove from the offices of the Clerk of Superior Court and Register of Deeds of Columbus County any records requiring repairs which must be made in the city of Raleigh or elsewhere under their supervision and control, said records to be returned to the appropriate custodian as soon as the necessary repairs are completed. This Board further authorizes the use of

appropriate space in the Columbus County Courthouse by the North Carolina Department of Archives and History for the aforementioned purposes and suggests that favorable consideration be given to the use of the conference room in the office of the Superior Court.

The following resolution was introduced by Commissioner H. J. Watts to the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County and was duly adopted:

WHEREAS, The industrial development of the State of North Carolina concerns the general welfare of its citizens, and

WHEREAS, The industrial development of the State of North Carolina provides employment for its citizens and additional tax revenue for its local governments, and

WHEREAS, The creation of jobs by industrial development is truly a public purpose, and

WHEREAS, It is believed by this Board that the State of North Carolina should implement every sound and legal method at its disposal to meet increasing competition in the field of industrial development by more than thirty other states currently using industrial revenue bonds to attract industry, and

WHEREAS, The use of industrial revenue bonds has been proven to be a sound, legal and effective method for attracting substantial and credit-worthy industrial concerns to locate facilities in states which use this method of financing,

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it resolved that this Board does recommend and urge its representatives and senators in the North Carolina General Assembly to support necessary legislation to authorize the issuance of industrial revenue bonds to finance the construction of and the equipping of industrial plants in the State of North Carolina.
