The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office at 10 a.m., June 5, 1967 it being first Monday.

The following business was transacted:

- Ordered: that a refund in the amount of \$41.60 be made to L. G. Ikner, Rt. 3, Whiteville, N. C. due to a 1956 Ford, valued at \$1,030, being listed in error for the year 1959 and 1960. Said auto was listed and paid in Charleston, S. C. by L. G. Ikner; Mrs. Ikner listed in Columbus County.

Dr. Eugene Douglas of the Robeson County Mental Health Association presented a 4-county mental health plan and requested that Columbus County join this along with Scotland, Bladen, and Robeson Counties. The proposed mental health center will be located in Robeson County and said county proposes to continue the clinic in Columbus County and to operate full time with a clinical worker and to have a psychiatrist available two days per week. A joint Mental Health Advisory Board composed of representatives from each county is proposed. Action on this matter was tabled until a further meeting.

Ordered: that S. Preston Douglas & Associates of Lumberton be awarded the contract to audit all funds and accounts of the office of Clerk of Court for the period beginning December 1, 1966 and ending November 30, 1967 at a rate of \$45 per day plus reasonable travel and subsistence expense for the services of each accountant engaged in the work. The chairman and clerk were authorized to execute said contract on behalf of the Board of Commissioners.

Ordered: that the sheriff be instructed to inform Deputy John Coleman that the travel expense of said deputy will be terminated beginning July 1st until such time as he returns to travel duty.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Mrs. Mattie G. White, Tatum Township, be cancelled for the year 1964 due to double listing. (Receipt #676).

Ordered: that poll tax listed in the name of Joseph William Suggs, Bug Hill Township, be cancelled for the year 1961. Mr. Suggs was in service at this time.

Ordered: that poll tax listed in the name of Grover Colis Stocks, Bug Hill Township, be released for the year 1966. Mr. Stocks is a resident of Virginia and pays poll tax in that state. (Receipt #525).

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of Mrs. Robert L. Dennis, Tatum Township, be cancelled for the year 1964 due to double listing.

Upon motion of Comm. Watts, seconded by Comm. Williamson, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

WHEREAS Sarah S. Redmon has heretofore executed a lien to the County of Columbus to secure the county for payments by the Welfare Department to her, and

WHEREAS said lien is recorded in the office of the Clerk of Superior Court in OAA Lien Book #1, page 470, and

WHEREAS certain property hereinafter described in which said Sarah S. Redmon owns an interest has a fair market value of \$400 after certain expenses and indebtedness have been satisfied, and

WHEREAS the net value of the interest of said Sarah S. Redmon in the property hereinafter described is \$400, and

WHEREAS R. C. Soles, Jr., County Attorney, has negotiated and collected said \$400 on behalf of Columbus County, and

WHEREAS Chester Graham, one of the heirs of said Sarah S. Redmon, deceased, and County Attorney R. C. Soles, Jr. requested that said property hereinafter described be released from OAA Lien Book #1, page 470, upon payment to the County of Columbus the sum of \$400 which sum represents the fair market value of the interest of said Sarah S. Redmon in and to said property, and

WHEREAS the Board of County Commissioners finds as a fact that said \$400 represents

the fair market value of the interest of said Sarah S. Redmon in and to said property, it is therefore moved and ordered that upon receipt of said \$400 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said property hereinafter shall be and now is and forever hereafter released and discharged from OAA Lien as recorded in Book #1, page 470.

The said property herein referred to and hereby released from OAA Lien is described as follows:

Beginning on a stake on the North side of the W. C. & A.R.R. in a ditch bank by a bridge across said ditch and runs with said ditch West 2-44/100 chains to a stake in Mrs. Blue's line; thence her line about 18° West 17-25/100 chains to her corner on a stump and pine pointer; thence about North 46° East Jackson Green's line 4-50/100 chains to a stake in Jackson Green's line; thence direct to the beginning containing six acres more or less, being the same as described in a deed dated October 4, 1913 from D. Graham to Geo. A. Redmond as recorded in Book 114, page 69, registry of Columbus County.
