

The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office at 10 a.m., July 3, 1967 it being first Monday.

Business Transacted:

Ordered: that a check be written for \$25.00 to George Turbeville from Out Door Poor Fund.

Ordered: that this Board finds as a fact that Deputy Sheriff John Coleman has returned to office and travel duty and by reason thereof is entitled to both salary and travel compensation. The county auditor is instructed to continue paying Deputy Coleman his full authorized salary and travel allowance.

Ordered: that Veneda S. Ray be paid for all holidays granted county employees and two weeks vacation but without benefit of sick leave.

Ordered: that J. Hubert Norris be reappointed Tax Collector and Tax Supervisor and Brooks Stanley reappointed Deputy Tax Collector. They are to continue services in same manner as before.

Ordered: that Sam Whitehead be allowed to display fireworks at the Whiteville Country Club on July 4, 1967.

Ordered: that the salary of Kathryn Harrelson be \$350.00 per month as bookkeeper in the Columbus County Tax Collectors' office.

Ordered: that Buell Lanier be appointed to serve the unexpired term of Columbus County Coroner subject to his acceptance.

Mr. Buell Lanier appeared before the Board and accepted the position of County Coroner. Mr. Lee J. Greer, Clerk of Superior Court, administered the oath of office.

Ordered: that the County Auditor is authorized to ammend the budget of the Agriculture Extension Service for the salary of the Negro Home Demonstration Agent \$476.00 per year. The increase was agreed on at the January 3rd meeting.

Ordered: that taxes listed in the name of A. L. Walters, Ransom Township be accepted at par for the year 1966. (Receipt #781)

Ordered: that personal taxes listed in the name of Oattie Young Moore, Bogue Township, be cancelled for the year 1961 due to double listing.

Ordered: that personal taxes listed in the name of C. D. Mercer, Chadbourn Township, be cancelled for the year 1956 due to double listing.

Ordered: that W. K. Cartrette, Williams Township, be allowed to pay taxes for years 1933-1962 with 10% penalty, 1963-1966 with full penalty.

Ordered: that Waccamaw Bank & Trust Company be named depository for the undistributed tax fund, all school funds and Community College funds and that Southern National Bank of N. C. be named depository for all other county funds for the fiscal year 1967-1968.

The Whiteville Merchants Association expressed to the Board their wishes for the county to contribute money for Christmas decorations for the county courthouse. All money contributed would be used for the courthouse decoration only. Commissioner H. J. Watts was appointed by the Board to meet with and discuss cost and etc. at the next Merchants Association meeting.

Letters of acknowledgment to Mr. Jim High of The News Reporter, and Mr. Horace Carter of the Tabor City Tribune, were sent for editorials written in the past months.

Letter from Department of Army dated 6-29-67 concerning weed control in the Simmons Bay Project to County Commissioners was referred to Mr. Raper, County Extension Chairman.

Dr. J. R. Black reported to the Board on all Mental Health meetings attended in past month.

Mr. Lacy Tate and Mr. Earl Bullard from the Columbus County Hospital Board of Trustees, appeared before the Board and asked that the county pay \$15.00 per day on the Welfare Patient Care. The county now pays \$10.00 per day. The Board made no decision since this money would have to come from the Co Operative Health Budget. Dr. Black will review this budget and report to Board at later date.

The Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County hereby approves the foregoing budget submitted by Columbus County Board of Education and appropriates to the County Board of Education the sum of \$6300.00 for the school year of 1967-1968 from county nontax funds and privately donated funds for the purposes described in this budget.

The following resolution was introduced by Commissioner Edward W. Williamson, seconded by Commissioner H. J. Watts and unanimously adopted by the Board, all members being present:

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of this Board that the Honorable Dan K. Moore, Governor of the State of North Carolina, has been authorized by the State Legislature to appoint qualified judges to the newly established Court of Appeals; and

WHEREAS, this Board deems the Honorable Raymond B. Mallard, Resident Judge of the Superior Court of the Thirteenth Judicial District, to be qualified by reason of education, experience and judicial temperament to serve as member of the Court of Appeals. This Board unanimously endorses him and recommends to the Governor that he favorably consider appointing said Raymond B. Mallard to the Court of Appeals; and

WHEREAS, if Judge Mallard is appointed to the Court of Appeals, it will be appropriate for the Governor to appoint a qualified person to the office of Resident Judge of Superior Court for the Thirteenth Judicial District; and

WHEREAS, this Board considers Honorable Sankey W. Robinson, a licensed attorney and member of the North Carolina Thirteenth Judicial District and Columbus County Bar Association, to be qualified by reason of education, experience and judicial temperament for the position of Resident Judge of Superior Court of the Thirteenth Judicial District. This Board unanimously endorses Mr. Robinson for said position and recommends to the Honorable Dan K. Moore, Governor

of the State of North Carolina, that Mr. Robinson be appointed Resident Judge of Superior Court of the Thirteenth Judicial District if a vacancy of the said office occurs.

It is ordered that a certified copy of this resolution be sent by the Clerk of this Board to Governor Dan K. Moore and a copy sent to Judge Raymond B. Mallard and Mr. Sankey W. Robinson.
