Mr. Carl Wilkins, a representative of S. Preston Douglas & Associates, Certified Public Accountants, presented to the Board the annual audit report of the Clerk of Superior Court. Upon motion made and duly seconded the report was accepted as presented.

Ordered: that a check in the amount of \$1,000 be given to the Simmons Bay Watershed Project for maintenance.

A delegation from the Simmons Bay Watershed, Gapway Watershed and Buck Creek Watershed appeared before the Board and asked they request the members of the 1969 General Assembly to enact a law to create a watershed conservation district within Columbus County. The Board assured the delegation of their full support.

Dr. J. R. Black, Health Director, presented to the Board several bids that had been received for the purchase of a new X-Ray machine for the county Health Dept. Mr. C. T. Harri representing the H. G. Mr. Bob Dawson and Mr. Jesse Fisher and other interested citizens appeared and asked the Board to consider assuming the Whiteville Airport as a county facility. A proposal was sumitted by the group and was accepted by the Board wherein the Town of Whiteville will convey to the county all real estate properties, improvements, fixtures and equipment used in the present operation of the Whiteville Airport and it shall be known as the Columbus County Airport. A committee named the Columbus County Airport Authority will consist of 18 members;

9 appointed by the Board of County Commissioners at large from all areas; 3 from Whiteville and 6 will be appointed by the municipalities of the county.

The Board of Education with Mr. John J. Hicks as spokesman, presented a budget proposal for the county school system for the year 1968-69. The budget submitted would increase the current tax rate approximately 21 cents. The Board did not approve this request.

The Budget Committee of the Board of Education reappeared and submitted a budget request for the year 1968-69 that would increase the current tax rate, 1611 over the amount leived for the year 1967-68. No decision of acceptance was made by the Board.
