WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Board that Federal funds may be available to assist in the construction of the proposed system.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County approves said project and will cooperate to the fullest extent in the successful conculsion thereof.

EVERGREEN

WHEREAS, a great need exists for a municipal water system in the Town of Evergreen; and

WHEREAS, the Evergreen Development Corporation has been duly incorporated to provide said services; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Board that Federal

may be available to assist in the construction of the proposed system.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County approves said project and will cooperate to the fullest extent in the successful conculsion thereof.

CHADBOURN

WHEREAS, a great need exists for a municipal sewer expansion in the Town of Chadbourn; and

WHEREAS, the Chadbourn Development Corporation has been duly incorporated to provide said services; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Board that federal funds may be available to assist in the construction of the proposed system.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County approves said project and will cooperate to the fullest extent in the successful conculsion thereof.

A group of interested citizens appeared before the Board and asked that a full time Employment Security Commission office be centrally located in the county. The county will have to provide office space and furnish all utilities. The Employment Security Commission will furnish all personnel and office furniture. At the present time, Employment Security officials are in Columbus County only one day per week.

Upon motion of Commissioner J. Roland Gore, seconded by Commissioner Edward W. Williamson, it was ordered that the county would furnish space and utilities for a full time Unemployment office to be centrally located in the county.

Ordered: that Jimmy Strickland, Cerro Gordo, N. C. be appointed to serve on the Board of Directors of Sencland Community Action, Inc., Mr. Strickland replaces Martin Carter.

Mr. Paul Wyche requested that the County Attorney sell the
Lillie Holloway property in Ransom Township for county taxes. (Lewis T. Holloway).

Members of the Tabor City Civitan Club asked the Board of Commissioners for assistance to keep the 200 bed Emengency Hospital acquired through the Civil Defense in Tabor City. The present facility being used is on school property and the Board of Education states it is needed for a vocational classroom. Commissioners stated they would cooperate with the Board of Education in an effort to keep the Emergency Hospital located in Tabor City.

The following motion was made by Commissioner Williamson, seconded by Commissioner Johnson, and unanimously carried and ordered as hereinafter set out, to wit:

WHEREAS, Loretta Ruth Elrod has heretofore executed a lien to the County of Columbus to secure the County for payments by the Department of Public Welfare; and

WHEREAS, the said Loretta Ruth Elrod and the County Attorney have requested that the said property hereinafter described be released from the said OAA lien as recorded in Lien Book # 1, Page 554, upon payment to the County of Columbus, the said sum of \$1,503.46 which represents the fair market value of said property heretofore owned by Loretta Ruth Elrod; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds as a fact that the foregoing is correct and that said \$1,503.46 represents and is a fair market value of the property hereinafter described heretofore owned by the said Loretta Ruth Flrod.

of \$1,503.46 paid to the County of Columbus, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said property hereinafter described shall be and is now and forever hereafter released and discharged from OAA Lien as recorded in OAA Lien Book # 1, Page 554, and any and all other OAA or Welfare Liens now held by the County of Columbus on said property whether the same be expressly hereinafter referred to or not, it being the expressed intention of the Board of Commissioners that all county liens on all said property, with the exception of any county taxes due, shall be discharged from said property.

The said property released from the above mentioned county lien or liens is described as follows:

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR COLUMBUS COUNTY ACCEPTING THE PROPERTY FORMERLY KNOWN AS THE WHITEVILLE AIRPORT PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the City of Whiteville owns certain real estate conveyed to it by the Whiteville Development Corporation by deed dated September 12, 1963 and recorded in Deed Book 232, Page 431, in the office of the Register of Deeds, Columbus County, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, the City of Whiteville had been unable to obtain necessary funds with which to improve said airport adequately and had been unable to provide funds for the hard surfacing of runway strip of said airport and by reason thereof the same was in a hazardous condition creating risk to air traffic entering and leaving said airport; and

WHEREAS, the City of Whiteville offered to convey said property, without consideration, to Columbus County to be operated by Columbus County as an airport for the County and entire surrounding regions; and

WHEREAS, by deed dated March 10, 1969, from the City of Whiteville to Columbus County as recorded in Deed Book 253, Page 359, in the office of the Register of Deeds, Columbus County, North Carolina, the City of Whiteville conveyed said airport property to Columbus County; and

WHEREAS, said conveyance was made under authority of a special act by the 1969 General Assembly.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County does hereby accept said property and does hereby assume responsibility for the maintenance, operation, and general supervision and improvement of said airport property; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners does hereby request all public governmental and business agencies in Columbus County to cooperate with this Board in promoting and improving the airport property for use by the public for the betterment of said county.
