WHEREAS, several proposals relative to the regionalization program have been submitted by individual and combined Boards of Commissioners and other agencies within the SEDD; and

WHEREAS, it is our desire to present a unified and considered position on the matter of the Regionalization of the area served by the SEDD,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the aforementioned ten counties do hereby, in concert, request placement in a Common Planning Region, which will conform to the previously established jurisdictional lines of the Southeastern Economic Development District. Be it FURTHER RESOLVED that all other recommended actions submitted by these governmental bodies which are in conflict with this resolution be removed from further consideration.
