The Honorable Board of County Commissioners met in their said office at 10:00 A.M., July 6, 1970, it being first Monday.

A public hearing was held at 10:00 A.M., concerning water safety regulations for Lake Waccamaw, Mr. Ned Council and Mr. R. G. Lytton, Jr. was present for the hearing. Upon motion of Commissioner Burns, seconded by Commissioner Johnson, and unanimously adopted that the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County petition the N. C. Wildlife Resources Commission to make special regulations to promote boating and water safety on Lake Waccamaw in Columbus County as authorized by G.S. 75A-15, and that the Commission is requested to give particular consideration to the proposed water safety regulations prepared by Lake Waccamaw Water Safety Committee and approved by the Board of County Commissioners.

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Upon motion of Commissioner Williamson, seconded by Commissioner Gore, the minutes of the June 15th meeting were approved as read.

Upon motion of Commissioner Williamson, seconded by Commissioner Burns, the minutes of the June 22 called meeting were approved as read.

Upon motion of Commissioner Gore, seconded by Commissioner schools Williamson, and unanimously adopted that Mr. Kacy Mercer be appointed as/electrical inspector to replace Mr. L. V. Holt.

Upon motion of Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Commissioner Burns and unanimously adopted that the Columbus County Social Services Board and Mrs. Alice Wright, Director of Social Services, be authorized to select an attorney to represent the Social Services Department and that the approved salary for said attorney is \$200 per month.

Mayor Leo Mercer of Chadbourn and Town Commissioner James

Duncan asked the Board of Commissioners to continue the present mental

health program in the county.

Mr. J. E. Ragsdale and Mr. Phillip Strickland representing the Tabor City Rescue Squad, requested that a radio be purchased by the county for use by the Tabor City Rescue Squad. Upon motion of Commissioner Gore, seconded by Commissioner Williamson, and unanimously adopted that the purchase of a radio for use by the Tabor City Rescue Squad be approved.

Upon motion of Commission Williamson, seconded by Commissioner Burns, that the 20¢ Jail Construction Levy set in the 1970-71 tentative budget estimate be modified to allow a 5% increase for the County Schools budget, 5% increase of county employees salaries and to continue the Mental Health Program and Day Care Center. Total levy for these changes to be taken from the 20¢ levy. The following vote was taken by the

Nays: Johnson, Gore

Chairman Watts voting nay. Upon count, Chairman Watts stated the nays carried.

Upon motion of Commissioner Johnson, seconded by Commissioner Gore and unanimously adopted that SEDC be officially designated as a planning agency and the following resolution was adopted:

ADDITIONAL DESIGNATION OF COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Southeastern Economic Development Commission was created as a joint effort by the Counties of Bladen, Brunswick, Columbus, Cumberland, Hoke, New Hanover, Pender, Robeson, Sampson and Scotland to foster economic development within the ten-county District; and

WHEREAS, comprehensive planning is the cornerstone of development;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Southeastern Economic Development Commission be officially designated as a district planning agency to serve the interests of the member counties and to engage in comprehensive planning for the development and orderly growth of the District.

Upon motion of Commissioner Burns, seconded by Commissioner Williamson, that the following resolution be unanimously adopted:

WHEREAS, by deed dated and recorded in deed book 253, page 359, Registry of Columbus County, the City of Whiteville conveyed to the County of Columbus, a certain tract or parcel of land located in Whiteville Township, Columbus County, North Carolina, heretofore used as an airport by the City of Whiteville and known as the Whiteville Muncipal Airport; and

WHEREAS, the County of Columbus is now the owner in fee simple of said airport property and has assumed all obligations of maintenance, operations, and control of said airport; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Columbus County deems it appropriate to rename said airport "The Columbus County Municipal Airport,"

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that hereafter the said airport shall be known and designated as "The Columbus County Municipal Airport."

J. Hubert Norris, Tax Collector, reported on 1969-70 tax collections.

Ordered: that the Town of Bolton be paid \$60 per month for magistrate rent beginning July 1, 1970.

Ordered: that the insurance coverage on the 1970 Ford Vann used as a police vehicle be increased from present limits to \$100,000 per person and \$300,000 each accident.

Mrs. Marion Stevens and a group of interested citizens requested the Board to continue the Day Care Program in the county under the supervision of the Mental Health Program. Upon discussion, the following action was taken: Upon motion of Commissioner Williamson, seconded by Commissioner Gore and unanimously adopted that the Mental Health Program and Day Care Center be continued in Columbus County and that the tentative budget be amended to continue these programs.

The following tax releases based on recommendations from the Tax Supervisor's Office:

Ordered: that the taxes listed in the name of William Smith, Ransom Township, beccancelled for the year 1969 due to double listing.

Ordered: that the taxes listed in the name of Ode Todd,
Waccamaw Township, be accepted at par for the years 1944 through 1969.

Ordered: that the taxes in the name of Bobby Vereen, South Williams Township, be accepted at par for the years 1966 through 1969.
