BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of Columbus County endorse and support the proposed changes in State taxes on A. B. C. Stores whereby more funds would remain for distribution in the localities paying the taxes and further benefits would be derived on the local level.

BE IT RESOLVED that the motion heretofore passed at the meeting of the Board on May 5, 1972 be sent to the State Department of Health, with a copy of the Plan for Solid Waste Disposal for Columbus County, as follows: "Mr. Beverly Paul, Executive Director of C. O. G., presented a plan that could be used by Columbus County in implementing the Solid Waste Program in Columbus County. After a discussion with other interested departments, a motion was passed unanimously that the plan be presented to the State Department of Health by Mr. Paul as the plan for Columbus County."

Mr. Belton Blackmon, Chief of Police, Brunswick, appeared before the Board to ask for funds for the operation of the Brunswick Ambulance Service. No action was taken on this request at this time, but a decision will be made at the next meeting.
